



Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 171 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
3/9	West River Rd.	Hunters	Complainant states that hunters were on West River Rd. shooting birds but were too close to the roadway. Deputies located the subjects who were shooting birds over the water.
3/9	Fix Rd.	Larceny	Complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) entered unlocked vehicles in his driveway. Nothing was reported missing or damaged.
3/9	West River Rd.	Fraud	Complainant states he received a call from Kingston, Jamaica and the male subject on the line told him that he won a large sum of money from Publisher's Clearing House. The subject stated the complainant would first need to send him money to complete the transaction. The complainant did not send money or give the subject any of his personal information. The Erie County Sheriffs Office warns residents to err on the side of caution when releasing personal information over the telephone. 3/9	Love Rd.	Suspicious Person	Complainant states that a vehicle pulled into his driveway and several subjects exited and knocked on his door. The complainant did not answer, and the vehicle left but then went to a neighbor's house. Deputies located the subjects, who were going door to door spreading the word of the gospel.
3/9	Cottagewood La.	Suspicious Person	Complainant states that several subjects were parked on the street and appeared to be entering a construction site. Deputies located the subjects who were students filming a project for school. No damage was observed.
3/9	Love Rd.	Reckless Operation	Complainant states that a vehicle was driving recklessly. Deputies located the vehicle and advised the driver.
3/9	Stony Point Rd.	ATV Operation	Complainant states that 2 ATV's were riding on his property. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the ATV's.
3/9	Stony Point Rd.	Residential Burglary	Complainant states he came home and noticed his

			residence had been broken into. Several items were reported missing. Erie County Sheriffs Detectives were able to recover some of the property in the following days and arrests are expected to be made. Investigation Ongoing.
3/10	Love Rd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call. Deputies spoke to the occupants and determined the call to be a misdial.
3/10	Ransom Rd.	Reckless Operation	Complainant states that a vehicle was driving recklessly. Deputies located the vehicle parked at a nearby residence and advised the driver.
3/10	Fix Rd.	Reckless Operation	Complainant states that motorcycles were racing up and down the street. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the motorcycles.
3/10	West River Rd.	Reckless Operation	Complainant states that a motorcycle was speeding on West River Rd. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the motorcycle.
3/10	Love Rd.	Customer Trouble	Employee at Sunoco states that a subject was loitering around the store and was asked to leave but refused. Deputies located the subject who left without incident.
3/10	East River Rd.	Open Burn	Deputies observed a moderate amount of smoke coming from the river's edge. The homeowner was on location and was burning yard clippings.
3/10	East River Rd.	Youth Activity	Complainant states that a group of kids was gathering in the street near Harvey Rd. Deputies located and advised the subjects, who were meeting up before going longboarding.
3/10	Carol La.	Suspicious Person	Complainant states a suspicious looking vehicle was driving slowly up and down the street. A subject exited the vehicle and began knocking on doors in the neighborhood. Deputies located the subject who was looking for a friend's house.
3/11	East River Rd.	Unlawful Possession of Marijuana	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested a Juvenile Offender for Unlawful Possession of Marijuana (a Violation). The Juvenile Offender was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
3/11	Ransom Rd.	Larceny	Complainant states that sometime in recent days, an unknown person stole various items from her unlocked vehicle.
3/11	Bedell Rd.	Animal Loose	Complainant states that her dog had just run away. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the animal. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
3/12	Town Hall Terr.	Barking Dog	Complainant states that a dog was barking for about an hour during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate and barking dogs.
3/12	Love Rd.	Suspicious Person	Employee at 711 states that a vehicle drove into the parking lot and a suspicious male subject got out and began walking around the store. Deputies located the subject and advised him. The subject left with no further incident.
3/12	Fix Rd.	Larceny	Complainant states that sometime during the day, an

			unknown person(s) stole mail from her mailbox.
3/12	Fix Rd.	Chimney Fire	Deputies assisted Grand Island Fire Department who handled a report of a chimney fire.
3/12	Stony Point Rd.	Reckless Operation	Complainant states a vehicle was swerving in and out of lanes of traffic. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle.
3/13	Whitehaven Rd.	Customer Trouble	Employees at Holiday Inn state that two subjects were possibly smoking marijuana in their hotel room. Deputies located the subjects and advised them. The subjects left without incident.
3/13	Grand Island Blvd.	Customer Trouble	Employees at Subway state that an intoxicated male customer was asked to leave the store and refused. Deputies located the subject and advised him. The subject left without incident.
3/13	Whitehaven Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
3/13	Bedell Rd.	Animal Complaint	Complainant states that a dog was on the porch of a neighboring apartment for about an hour and was worried due to the frigid temperature. Deputies located the animal, which appeared in good health, and were able to get it inside the apartment.
3/14	West River Rd.	Suspicious Incident	Complainant states that a vehicle pulled into her driveway and began to honk the horn. The vehicle then left in an unknown direction. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle.
3/14	Whitehaven Rd.	Reckless Operation	Complainant states that the driver of a vehicle appeared to be drinking an alcoholic beverage and then pulled over to the shoulder of the road and began vomiting. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle.
3/15	Jenell Dr.	Animal Loose	Complainant states that a dog was running loose in the neighborhood. The dog was returned to the owner.
3/15	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Incident	Employees at Laundry Lounge state that it appeared a male subject had locked himself in the bathroom. Deputies checked but no persons were found inside the bathroom.
3/15	Town Hall Terr.	Suspicious Incident	Complainant states a male subject called him and stated he was from National Grid. The subject stated that he needed the complainants banking information to deposit a rebate. The complainant did not give the subject his information. Suspicious Incident	Complainant states that he received a phone call from an unknown male subject stating he worked for Blue Cross Blue Shield and needed the complainant to verify personal information.
