



## Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 191 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on Grand Island.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
3/12	Whitehaven Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Deputies located a suspicious vehicle parked outside of a closed business during the late hours of the night. The driver of the vehicle was located and determined to be the owner of the business.
3/12	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	Deputies located a vehicle on the property of Fantasy Island while the park was closed. The occupants were determined to be landscapers completing work on location.
3/12	Park La.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a female subject parked a vehicle on the street in front of her residence during the previous night and walked into a nearby house and never returned. Deputies found the vehicle but were unable to locate the driver.
3/12	Red Jacket Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject was walking down the street taking pictures of houses. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the male by the description given.
3/12	Alvin Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states he observed several vehicles up on cinder blocks at Fucillo Chevrolet. It was determined these were previous thefts already reported to Patrol.
3/13	S Colony Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a vehicle was parked in a neighbor's driveway that did not belong. Deputies checked the residence but found nothing out of order.
3/13	South State Pkwy.	Property Found	The complainant states she saw a flat screen TV near the bike path while walking in the area. Deputies located the broken TV and took it to the substation.
3/13	Grand Island Blvd.	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that another vehicle ran him off the road in the area of Burger King and then fled the scene. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
3/13	Queens Dr.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that she came home and found her front door open. Deputies checked the residence but found no persons or signs of disturbance inside.
3/14	Enola Rd.	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that 2 vehicles from a nearby

			residence were speeding down the street. Deputies located the vehicles at the registered owners address and advised the drivers.
3/15	Love Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	Deputies observed a vehicle pull into the parking lot of Sunoco during the late hours of the night after the business was closed. The driver got out and started walking around the business. Deputies stopped the vehicle when it left and determined the driver was picking up unsmoked cigarette butts for personal use.
3/15	Sunset Dr.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	The complainant states that a vehicle parked on the street during the late hours of the night, the 2 occupants got out and appeared to be looking into cars. Deputies located the subjects at a nearby address and determined they were visiting friends in the house.
3/15	Bedell Rd.	Property Found	Deputies located a bicycle on the bike path between Country Glen Apartments and South La. The bicycle was brought back to the substation.
3/15	South La.	Burglary In Progress	Deputies responded to a report of a male subject attempting to break into a shed. The complainant chased the subject toward the bike path but lost sight of him. Deputies located footprints leading to the Country Glen Apartments but were unable to locate the subject by the description given. Numerous items of evidence were recovered and sent for DNA/fingerprint testing.
3/15	East River Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
3/15	Grand Island Blvd.	Animal Loose	Deputies located a loose dog on the side of the road. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
3/15	Baseline Rd.	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported.
3/16	West Oakfield Rd.	Animal Complaint	The complainant states that he had an unknown animal stuck in his bathroom and it was making noises. Deputies successfully removed the animal.
3/16	Ransom Rd.	Wires Down	Deputies responded to a report of wires down. The phone company was advised.
3/16	West River Pkwy.	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that a vehicle was swerving all over the road and was last seen headed east on Fix Rd. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
3/16	West River Rd.	Road Obstruction	Deputies removed a box of spray paint that was in the roadway causing a hazard.
3/16	Ransom Rd.	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that 2 vehicles were in the parking lot of Grand Island High School doing donuts during the late evening hours. Deputies located the 2 vehicles and issued traffic summonses.
3/16	West River Pkwy.	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that 2 vehicles were drag racing on the parkway near Bush Rd. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicles by the descriptions given.
3/16	Fernwood La.	Animal Complaint	The complainant states he observed a black bear in the area around his address. Deputies checked but found no signs of the animal and could not confirm it was a black bear.

3/16	Baseline Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
3/17	Sandy Beach Rd.	Fraud	The complainant states he received a phone call yesterday from a male subject who claimed the complainant's granddaughter was in jail and needed bail money. The complainant was directed to forward a money order through Western Union and sent the money. The complainant received another call from the same male claiming his granddaughter now needed money to pay for her medical bills because she was hit by a car. He became suspicious and called Patrol. Deputies advise never give personal information or money to any persons contacting them through phone, email, text messaging or any other source as most likely it is a scam.
3/17	East River Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states he was walking his dog and found 2 hypodermic needles in the roadway. Deputies confiscated the needles and disposed of them.
3/17	Love Rd.	Youth Activity	The complainant states that several youths were hanging out on the pedestrian bridge. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the youths by the description given.
3/18	Baseline Rd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a 911 hang up call at a residence. The call was determined to be made accidentally.
3/18	East Park Rd.	Animal Loose	The complainant states that her dog got loose from the residence. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
