The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 133 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

3/14	Whitehaven Rd.	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a vehicle was swerving all over the roadway while traveling on the I-190 before exiting the thruway at Whitehaven Rd. where the complainant lost sight of it. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
3/14	South State Pkwy.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 30 y/o Jennifer Washington of Buffalo for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed her license was currently revoked. Washington was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
3/14	Lang Blvd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call at a local business during the early morning hours. The call was determined to be a misdial.
3/14	Stony Point Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a door was open to a neighbor's residence and it did not appear that anyone was home. Deputies checked and confirmed the occupants were home.
3/15	Beaver Island State Park	Vehicle off the roadway	Deputies responded to a report of a vehicle that left the roadway and became stuck. No injuries were reported.
3/15	Whitehaven Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident near the intersection of Alvin Rd. No injuries were reported.
3/16	West River Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Deputies located an occupied suspicious vehicle parked near the intersection of Fix Rd. The driver was advised and left without incident.
3/16	Wallace Dr.	Found Property	The complainant states that a bicycle was left near the stop sign at the intersection of South Park weeks ago. Deputies recovered the bicycle and transported it to the Grand Island Substation
3/16	I-190	Warrant Arrest	Deputies arrested 43 y/o James Haynes of Tonawanda on an outstanding warrant after the subject was turned over from Niagara Falls PD after being involved in an

			unrelated incident in their jurisdiction. Haynes was transported to the Erie County Holding Center.
3/16	Westwood Dr.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	The complainant states that a male subject was driving an older model Buick Regal around the neighborhood going door to door looking for work. The male left in the vehicle prior to the arrival of Patrol. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subject by the description given.
3/16	East River Rd.	Warrant Arrest	Deputies arrested 39 y/o Richard Aurand of Spanaway NY on and outstanding warrant after the subject was involved in an unrelated complaint with the New York State Police. Aurand was transported to the Erie County Holding Center.
3/17	Whitehaven Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.
3/17	Alvin Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.
3/17	Staley Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that he was receiving multiple phone calls from a male subject claiming to be a representative of the FBI and Publishers Clearing House and was trying to obtain the complainant's personal information. The complainant was advised the calls were most likely a scam.
3/18	Bedell Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that he smelled an odor of marijuana in the hallway of her apartment complex in Country Glen. Deputies checked and were unable to detect any odor of marijuana.
3/19	Love Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states a male subject was walking door to door with a gas can. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the male by the description given.
3/19	Baseline Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a female subject climbed through a window of a neighboring residence and then unlocked the door for the other 2 subjects she was with. Deputies located the subjects inside the residence and determined the female subject resided at the house.
3/19	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident in the parking lot of Tim Hortons. No injuries were reported.
3/20	Whitehaven Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle became disabled.
3/20	Bedell Rd.	Loud Music	The complainant states that a neighboring apartment was playing loud music during the late hours of the night. Deputies spoke with the occupants and advised them.
3/20	Whitehaven Rd.	Burglary	Employees of Cannon Design state that sometime overnight an unknown person(s) smashed the front doors of the business and stole numerous items from inside. Investigation Ongoing.
3/20	Schwegler Rd.	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a male subject appeared to be driving his vehicle around while he was intoxicated. Deputies located the male subject at a nearby residence and determined he was not intoxicated.
