

Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 191 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **<u>Grand Island</u>**.

3/15	East River Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that during the late hours of the night, an unknown person rang her doorbell then fled her property in an unknown direction. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any subjects.
3/15	West River Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states a suspicious vehicle was parked in front of his residence during the late hours of the night. Deputies located the vehicle and spoke to the driver who was at a friend's house nearby.
3/15	Staley Rd.	Refer to Patrol	The complainant states that a stop sign was down at an intersection on Stony Point Rd. extension. NITTEC was notified.

When the manager confronted the person, the subject left on foot. An Off Duty Buffalo Police Officer, who was on location, witnessed the incident and was able to apprehend the subject nearby and held him for Deputies. The subject was identified as 43 y/o Gregory Swan of Grand Island and was charged with Petit Larceny (Class A Misdemeanor), Obstruction of Governmental Administration (Class A Misdemeanor) and Resisting Arrest (Class A Misdemeanor). Swan was transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending his arraignment in the Town of Grand Island Court. The complainant states that a vehicle was swerving all

Deputies arrested 33 y/o Matthew Lazzaro of Grand Island for Obstruction of Governmental Administration 2 nd Degree (Class A Misdemeanor) and Resisting Arrest (Class A Misdemeanor). A search warrant was obtained for Lazzaro's residence and Deputies seized approximately 250 marijuana plants inside. Lazzaro was further charged with Criminal Possession of Marijuana 2 nd Degree (Class A Misdemeanor). Lazzaro was transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending
