The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 173 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
3/16	West River Rd.	Suspicious Incident	Complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) rearranged items that were in her yard. No damage was reported.
3/17	Bedell Rd.	Suspicious Incident	Complainant states that several vehicles pulled up in front of her house late at night and several subjects exited. Deputies located the vehicles, one of which that had broken down and the subjects were on location assisting the driver.
3/17	Grand Island Blvd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.
3/17	Grand Island Blvd.	Assault	Complainant states that he was assaulted by a male subject who was unfamiliar to him while he was at TC's Lounge. The complainant was transported to a local area hospital where he received treatment for seemingly non-life threatening injuries. Investigation Pending.
3/17	South State Pkwy	Drunk Driving	Following an investigation of a PDO Accident, Deputies arrested 24 y/o Brittany Clarke for Driving While Intoxicated. Clarke registered a .19% B.A.C. after submitting a sample of her breath for chemical analysis. Clarke was further charged with Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated due to her elevated readings. Clarke was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
3/18	Grand Island Blvd.	Property Lost	Complainant states that she found an unknown persons car keys in the parking lot of Tops. Deputies were able to determine who the owner was and were able to return them.
3/18	Ransom Rd.	Animal Loose	Complainant states that a dog was running loose in the neighborhood. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
3/18	West Park Ct.	Larceny	Complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) stole various items from her unlocked vehicle.
3/18	East River Rd.	Fraud	Complainant states he received a call from foreign sounding male subject who told him that he won a large sum of money from a lottery. The subject stated the

			complainant would first need to send him money to complete the transaction. The complainant did not send money or give the subject any of his personal information. The Erie County Sheriff's Office warns residents to err on the side of caution when releasing personal information over the telephone. 3/18	Cox Rd.	Animal Loose	Complainant states that a dog was running loose in the neighborhood. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
3/18	Bedell Rd.	Criminal Mischief	Complainant states that sometime in recent days, an unknown person(s) slashed the tires on her vehicle while it was parked in the apartment complex lot.
3/18	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.

3/20	Whitehaven Rd.	Animal Loose	Complainant states that a dog was running loose in the neighborhood. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
3/20	Bishops Gate Rd.	Pistol Permit Investigation	Deputies conducted a background check of an individual who applied for a pistol permit.
