The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 375 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

03/14	Larceny	E. River Road	Deputies are investigating missing boat & Trailer. Investigation ongoing.
03/15	Fight	Grand Island Bd	NFTA reported a fight between mutual combatants on a bus. Deputies arrived and separated the subjects. Neither party injured and no charges wanted by either participant. NFTA Police transported one subject and the other was allowed to remain on the bus.
03/16	Fire-Vehicle	Ransom Rd.	Deputies received a call of a rollover accident involving a vehicle versus utility pole and the vehicle was on fire. Deputies arrived and were able to confirm that both occupants were out of the vehicle and the vehicle was fully involved. Grand Island Fire extinguished the fire and the power company came to repair the pole.
03/17	Suspicious Vehicle	Grand Island Blvd.	Deputies received a call about a vehicle parked in a lot for an extended period of time with an occupant inside. Patrol arrived and tried to speak with the occupant inside but the subject refused to roll down the window. Patrol advised the occupant to leave immediately and the vehicle did leave without incident.
03/17	Traffic Arrest	Bedell Rd.	Deputies initiated a traffic stop of a vehicle for traffic infractions. The vehicle was unregistered. The driver would not cooperate or produce identification. The driver was placed under arrest and transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending proper identification and arraignment.
03/19	Burglary - Garage	Crescent Rd.	Deputies responded to speak with a complainant reporting their garage window broken and a sign stolen. Deputies are investigating further.
