The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 151 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
2/22	Broadway	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that her vehicle was damaged at an unknown time by unknown person(s). Deputies advised the complainant.
2/22	Grand Island Blvd.	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a vehicle almost struck him in the parking lot of the Dollar Tree. The vehicle left in an unknown direction prior to the arrival of Patrol. Deputies checked the surrounding area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
2/22	Bedell Rd.	Parking Violation	The complainant states that a vehicle was unlawfully parked in a handicap spot in the Country Glen Apartment parking lot. Deputies cited the vehicle for the violation.
2/23	Love Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a male subject was sleeping at the wheel of a vehicle in the 711 parking lot.
2/23	Love Rd.	Drunk Driving	Following the investigation of the above incident, Deputies arrested 24 y/o David Schmidt for Driving While Intoxicated and a traffic infraction. Schmidt registered a .14% B.A.C. after submitting a sample of his breath for chemical analysis. Schmidt was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court and released to a sober 3 rd party.
2/23	Bedell Rd.	Accident Hit & Run	The complainant states that she was involved in a PDO accident and while trying to retrieve documents for the information exchange, the driver of the other vehicle sped off almost striking her in the process. Deputies located the vehicle and driver nearby and arrested 53 y/o James McGraw of Grand Island for Reckless Endangerment 2 nd Degree (Class A Misdemeanor) and several traffic infractions. McGraw was transported to the Erie County Holding Center in lieu of \$250.00 bail.
2/23	First St.	Burglary In Progress	The complainant states that 2 youths were entering an abandoned residence nearby. Deputies arrived on scene and observed 2 subjects fleeing the house in question on foot. 1 subject was apprehended in a nearby yard and the other was apprehended near West River Rd. After the subjects were detained, in a search of the abandoned

			residence Deputies located a small marijuana grow operation in a bed room. The 17 and 15 y/o subjects were each charged with Burglary 3 rd Degree (Class D Felony), Unlawfully Growing Cannabis (Class A Misdemeanor), Obstruction of Governmental Administration 2 nd Degree (Class A Misdemeanor), Theft of Service (Class A Misdemeanor) and Resisting Arrest (Class A Misdemeanor). The 17 y/o offender was transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending his arraignment in the Town of Grand Island Court. The 15 y/o Offender was issued an appearance ticket returnable to Erie County Family Court and released to the custody of his parents.
2/23	Whitehaven Rd.	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that several vehicles were racing down the street. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicles by the description given.
2/23	Majestic Woods Dr.	Identity Theft	The complainant states that numerous fraudulent charges were made on his credit card by an unknown person(s).
2/24	Grand Island Blvd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.
2/25	Town Hall Terr.	Loud Music	The complainant states that a neighbor in a nearby apartment was playing his music loud. Deputies spoke to the subject and advised him.
2/25	Baseline Rd.	Warrant Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 25 y/o Daniel Kilian of Buffalo after a check showed he had an outstanding Bench Warrant from the Town of Tonawanda. Kilian was transferred to the custody of the Town of Tonawanda Police Department.
2/25	Love Rd.	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a vehicle cut him off and was speeding down the road. Deputies located the vehicle which was parked at a nearby business and advised the driver.
2/25	The Commons St.	Property Found	The complainant states that she found a bag full of gym clothes and wanted to turn it in to Patrol.
2/25	Bedell Rd.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that an unknown person(s) damaged a political periodical by defacing the document.
2/25	South State Pkwy.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
2/26	Stony Point Rd.	Wires Down	Deputies responded to a report of a low hanging wire. National Grid was notified.
2/26	Baseline Rd.	Welfare Check	The complainant states that an elderly male was walking in the middle of the road. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any subjects in the roadway.
