The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 149 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
2/23	Bedell Rd.	Loud Music	Complainant states that loud music was coming from an apartment in his complex. Deputies spoke to the occupants and advised them.
2/23	West River Rd.	Youth Activity	Complainant states that she saw 2 youths throwing snowballs at her residence during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the youths. No damage was reported.
2/23	North Colony Rd.	Accident Hit & Run	Complainant states that a large pickup truck struck his mailbox and then fled the area in an unknown direction. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any vehicles matching the description.

2/23	Town Hall Terr.	Suspicious Vehicle	Security Staff at Town Hall Terr state that a suspicious vehicle was sitting in the parking lot for an unusual amount of time and appeared to be occupied. Deputies located the vehicle nearby and determined that the driver was visiting a friend in the complex.
2/24	Whitehaven Rd.	Larceny	Complainant states that sometime in recent weeks, an unknown person(s) stole various items from his boat while it was in storage at a local marina. Deputies observed several boats with similar damage and attempted to contact the owners. Investigation Ongoing.

2/24	Grand Island Blvd.	Traffic Control Device	Complainant states that the traffic light on Grand Island Blvd. at Whitehaven was not working properly.

3/1	Grand Island Blvd.	Welfare Check	Complainant states she was unable to reach her mother after calling her numerous times and believed the mother was staying with a friend on Grand Island. Deputies located the mother at a local business and advised her.
3/1	Bedell Rd.	Suspicious Person	Complainant states that 2 subjects were walking down the street late at night and appeared to be looking in neighborhood mailboxes. Deputies located the 2 subjects and advised them.
3/1	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	Complainant states that 2 subjects were seen loitering inside of the First Niagara Bank ATM vestibule. Deputies located the subjects who stated they were waiting for the bus. The subjects were advised.

3/1	Ransom Rd.	Suspicious Person	Complainant states that a suspicious vehicle was parked on the street and appeared to be dealing drugs. Deputies located the vehicle and advised the driver.
