



Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 163 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
3/29	Ward Park Rd.	Loud Music	The complainant states loud music was coming from a nearby residence during the late hours of the night. Deputies located the residence in question and advised the occupants.
3/29	Whitehaven Rd.	Suspicious Person	An employee of Byblos Niagara Resort and Spa states that 2 subjects entered the hotel unlawfully and were hanging around the pool area during the late hours of the night. Deputies located the subjects and removed them from the premise at the request of staff. The complainant declined to press charges for trespassing.
3/29	East River Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a suspicious truck was parked in the driveway of a neighbor's residence. Deputies located the vehicle and driver who was on location to begin construction on the residence.
3/29	Stony Point Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.
3/29	Whitehaven Rd.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 34 y/o Sonny Zimmerman of Niagara Falls for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his license was currently suspended. Zimmerman was transported to the Erie County Holding Center in lieu of \$250 bail.
3/29	Cardinal La.	ATV Operation	The complainant states that a neighbor was revving the engine of his ATV loudly. Deputies located the subject and advised him.
3/29	East River Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
3/30	Love Rd.	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a vehicle was speeding and swerving all over the roadway. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
3/30	Industrial Dr.	Open Door	The complainant states while he was plowing a nearby lot he observed an open door at a closed business. Deputies checked the business and found no persons inside. The door appeared to be an oversight by

			employees.
3/30	Alvin Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that before the trade in sale for her vehicle was complete at Fucillo Toyota, an unknown person(s) stole personal papers and miscellaneous items from inside.
3/30	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	An employee of Bailly's Food Mart stated that a suspicious male subject was hanging around the business just before closing and now the complainant was afraid to leave the store. Deputies checked the area for the subject but were unable to locate him. Patrol stayed on location while the employee locked up and left the store.
3/31	Warner Dr.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that an unknown person was in her driveway looking into vehicles during the late hours of the night. The subject then began to knock on the complainant's door and repeatedly rang the doorbell. Deputies located the subject, who was highly intoxicated, and determined he had fallen nearby and injured himself. The subject was transported to a local area hospital with seemingly non-life threatening injuries.
3/31	Alvin Rd.	Larceny	Employees of Fucillo Chevrolet state that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) stole 4 tires from a vehicle on the sales lot.
3/31	West River Rd.	Accident Injury	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a telephone pole. One driver was transported to a local area hospital with seemingly non-life threatening injuries.
4/1	East Park Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.
4/1	East Park Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that he found what appeared to be a human bone on his front lawn. Deputies determined the bone to be from an unknown animal.
4/1	Carter Creek Dr.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) stole various items from his unlocked vehicle.
4/1	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject walking down the road appeared to be intoxicated and was flagging down vehicles. Deputies located the male subject who stated he was waiting for the bus.
4/1	Love Rd.	Youth Activity	The complainant states that several youths were drinking alcohol on the basketball courts at Kaegabine Elementary School. Deputies checked and determined the complaint to be unfounded.
4/1	Love Rd.	Suspicious Incident	An employee of 711 states that she found a hypodermic needle in the parking lot of the business. The needle was taken by Patrol and disposed of in a medical waste container.
4/2	Stony Point Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) stole the tires off of his wife's vehicle.
4/2	West River Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that a known subject stole his wallet from his residence in recent days. Investigation Ongoing.

4/2	Park Pl.	Identity Theft	The complainant states that an unknown person(s) used her Social Security number to file a false tax return in her name.
4/2	Grand Island Blvd.	Larceny	An employee of Bailly's Food Market states that a male subject stole various items from the store and left on foot. Deputies located the subject nearby and recovered the stolen property. Their investigation led to the arrest of 19 y/o Zion Brunson of Amherst for Petit Larceny (Class A Misdemeanor). Brunson was transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending his arraignment in the Town of Grand Island Court.
4/3	Ransom Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
4/3	Grand Island Blvd.	Traffic / Narcotics Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 43 y/o Gregory Swan of Grand Island for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his license was currently suspended. Swan was also charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 7 th Degree (Class A Misdemeanor), Promoting Prison Contraband 2 nd Degree (Class A Misdemeanor) and Tampering with Physical Evidence (Class E Felony) after he was found to be in possession of prescription drugs. Swan was transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending his arraignment in the Town of Grand Island Court.
4/3	Grand Island Blvd.	Warrant Arrest	While investigating the above Traffic Stop, Deputies also arrested 44 y/o Kellie Innes of Grand Island for False Personation (Class B Misdemeanor) after the subject used a false name to conceal the fact she had warrants for her arrest. A check of her real name showed Innes had 2 outstanding Warrants from the City of Buffalo and 1 from the Town of West Seneca. Innes was transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending her arraignment in the Town of Grand Island Court.
4/4	Whitehaven Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.
4/4	Old Carriage House Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
