



## Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 184 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

4/6	Grand Island Blvd.	Reckless Operation	Complainant states that a vehicle was swerving all over the roadway. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle.

Deputies investigation led to the arrest of 24 y/o Anthony Melia of Rochester for Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Class A Misdemeanor) and Harassment 2 <sup>nd</sup> Degree (Violation). Melia was transported to the Erie County Holding Center in lieu of \$600 bail.

Disorderly Conduct	While Deputies were on location at Holiday Inn they arrested 21 y/o Alexander Breur of Boxborough NY and 22 y/o Alyssa Faticone of Buffalo for Disorderly Conduct (Violation). Breur was transported to the Erie County Holding Center in lieu of \$100 bail and Faticone

			was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
4/6	Whitehaven Rd.	Criminal Mischief	Deputies responded to a report of a disturbance at Holiday Inn. Numerous car windows were broken as a result of beer bottles being thrown at them. Deputies investigation led to the arrest of 19 y/o Zachary Samach of Northumberland for Criminal Mischief 3 <sup>rd</sup> Degree (Class E Felony). Samach was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.

Myers was arraigned in the Town of Grand Island Court and remanded to the custody of the Erie County Sheriff's Office in lieu of \$10,000 bail.
