The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 166 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
4/9	East River Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	Deputies located a suspicious vehicle parked at a closed business during the late hours of the night. The occupants were advised and left without incident.
4/9	Staley Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that while she was working at Fresenius Kabi, an unknown person(s) stole items from her locker.
4/9	Baseline Rd.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 21 y/o Imani Davis of Niagara Falls for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 2 nd Degree (Misdemeanor) after a DMV check showed his license was currently revoked. Davis was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
4/9	West River Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that he found a syringe and wanted to turn it over to Patrol. Deputies confiscated the syringe and discarded it appropriately.
4/10	Grand Island Blvd.	Drunk Driving	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 30 y/o Jamie Kraft of Buffalo for Driving While Intoxicated (Misdemeanor). Kraft registered a .20% B.A.C. after submitting a sample of his breath for chemical analysis. Kraft was additionally charged with Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated due to the elevated level of his BAC. Kraft was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
4/10	West River Rd.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 23 y/o Emily Harrison of Grand Island for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 2 nd Degree (Misdemeanor), Circumventing a interlock device in a motor vehicle (misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed her license was currently revoked. Harrison was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
4/10	Continental La.	Accident Hit & Run	The complainant states that while her vehicle was parked at a local business it was struck by another car which fled the scene. No injuries were reported.
4/10	Staley Rd.	Drunk	The complainant states that an intoxicated male subject

			was at St. Timothy's Lutheran Church and refused to leave. Deputies advised the subject who left without incident.
4/11	Dolphin Dr.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject knocked on her door and then took off. Deputies located the subject nearby and determined he was conducting door to door sales and had the proper paperwork to do so.
4/12	East River Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	The complainant states that 2 male subjects parked a vehicle at the end of her driveway, got out and walked around before getting back in the vehicle and leaving the area. Deputies checked but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given. Nothing was reported damaged or stolen.
4/12	West River Pkwy.	Accident Injury	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. Both drivers were transported to local hospitals with seemingly non-life threatening injuries.
4/13	Harvey Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that several items of jewelry went missing from his residence and he suspects a female who cleans his home to be responsible for the theft. Investigation Ongoing.
4/14	West Park Rd.	Animal Bite	The complainant states she was bitten by a dog when she went to pet it while walking down the street. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
4/15	Stony Point Rd.	Wires Down	Deputies responded to a report of low hanging wires. The cable company was advised.
4/15	South State Pkwy.	Accident Injury	Deputies responded to a report of a motorcycle accident at the exit from the I-190. The driver of the motorcycle was taken by Mercy Flight to a local hospital with serious injuries.
4/15	Love Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	The complainant states a suspicious occupied vehicle was parked at Kaegabine Elementary School during the late evening hours. Deputies located the vehicle and advised the occupants.
4/15	Waterford Pk.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that 2 males were walking down the street looking into houses before getting into a vehicle and leaving the area. Deputies located the vehicle nearby and advised the occupants.
4/15	Whitehaven Rd.	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that a vehicle was swerving all over the road and almost took out a mailbox before the complainant lost sight of it. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
4/15	Whitehaven Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
