

Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary Dates: 4/11/2015 to 4/17/2015

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 171 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **<u>Grand Island</u>**.

4/11	Long Rd.	Traffic Arrest / Unlawful Possession of Marijuana	 Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 34 y/o Antione Hudson of Niagara Falls for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 2nd Degree (Misdemeanor), Unlawful Possession of Marijuana (Violation) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his license was currently suspended. Hudson was transported to the Erie County Holding Center in lieu of \$250 bail.
4/11	Whitehaven Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that sometime during the night a window was damaged on the Trinity United Methodist Church. Deputies checked and the damaged appeared to be caused by weather or a small animal.
4/11	Baseline Rd.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) smashed the windows on 3 school buses parked in the lot of Sidway Elementary School.
4/11	Whitehaven Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject was stumbling around while walking on the side of the road. Deputies located the male subject and after speaking with him learned he had a physical ailment.
4/11	Baseline Rd.	Fire	Deputies assisted the Grand Island Fire Department with the report of a dryer fire.
4/11	East River Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Deputies located a suspicious vehicle parked near the intersection of Edgewater Ave. during the late evening hours. It was determined the driver was delivering pizza's for a local business.
4/11	Long Rd.	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a vehicle was swerving all over the road and slamming on its breaks then speeding up. Deputies located the vehicle parked in a nearby business unoccupied and were unable to locate the driver.
4/12	Grand Island Blvd.	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a vehicle was all over the roadway near the intersection of Whitehaven Rd. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
4/12	Carl Rd.	Loud Music	The complainant states that loud music and noise was coming from a nearby apartment during the late hours of

			the night. Deputies located the apartment in question and advised the occupants.
4/12	West River Rd.	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported.
4/13	Stony Point Rd.	Road Obstruction	Deputies assisted a motorist who had items fall from his vehicle and cause a traffic hazard in the roadway.
4/14	Marlin Rd.	Fraud	The complainant states that an unknown person(s) filed a tax return in his name without his authorization.
4/14	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident Hit & Run	The complainant states that a white colored vehicle struck her car in the roundabout and then fled the scene. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
4/14	Beaver Island State Park	Reckless Operation	The complainant states while walking her dog in the park, she witnessed a pickup truck driving recklessly through the park. The occupants then exited the vehicle and got into kayaks before heading out on the Niagara River. Deputies were unable to locate the subjects.
4/14	East River Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject wearing dirty clothes and a backpack was walking down the road in the area of Fix Rd. Deputies located the subject who state he was walking to the bus stop.
4/15	Whitehaven Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.
4/15	Whitehaven Rd.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that subjects occupying a vehicle traveling in the opposite direction on Whitehaven Rd. threw rocks at her car and caused damage. The complainant was able to obtain a plate number. Deputies located the vehicle and advised the occupants. The complainant declined to pursue charges.
4/15	Riverwoods Dr.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a younger female subject knocked on her door asking for directions. After the female left, she returned several times in the next few days and complimented the complainant on her hardwood floors in her home and asked to see them. The complainant was advised to call Patrol immediately if the female showed up to the house again.
4/15	East River Rd.	Accident Hit & Run / Traffic Arrest	The complainant states that his parked vehicle was struck by another car which then attempted to flee the scene. The complainant got into his vehicle and chased after the car and was able to obtain a plate number. Deputies investigation led to the arrest of 30 y/o Jeffrey Eberhard of Grand Island for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 2 nd Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his license was currently revoked. Eberhard was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
4/16	Fix Rd.	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a vehicle was swerving all over the roadway and almost struck several parked vehicles. Deputies checked the area and found the vehicle unoccupied parked in the driveway of the registered owners address.

			of them stole her purse while on the premise.
