The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 174 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
4/18	South State Pkwy	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a vehicle was swerving all over the road and nearly crashed. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
4/18	Ferry Rd.	Customer Trouble	An employee of Sand-Dees Pub states that an intoxicated male and a female subject were refusing to pay their bill and causing a disturbance with other patrons of the bar. The subjects left prior to the arrival of Patrol. Deputies spoke with the employee who confirmed the subjects paid their bill before leaving and did not wish to pursue anything further.
4/18	Bedell Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that she could smell marijuana in the hallway of her apartment building. Deputies checked and determined the complaint to be unfounded.
4/18	Lasalle Ave.	Suspicious Vehicle / Unlawful Possession of Marijuana	The complainant states that a vehicle was parked in the street during the late hours of the night and the occupants appeared to be smoking marijuana. Deputies located the vehicle and their investigation led to the arrest of 22 y/o Christopher Demaria and 22 y/o Joseph Neuhaus both of Grand Island for Unlawful Possession of Marijuana (Violation). Both subjects were issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
4/18	East River Rd.	Parking Violation	Deputies located a trailer that was parked in the middle of the roadway. It was determined the trailer belonged to a construction company nearby. The trailer was removed by the owner.
4/18	Huth Rd.	Animal Loose	The complainant states that his dog was running loose in the neighborhood.
4/18	Love Rd.	Animal Complaint	The complainant states that a dog from a nearby residence got loose and attacked her dog. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
4/18	Love Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident in the parking lot of 711. No injuries were reported.
4/18	Ransom Rd.	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a motorcycle was driving

			down the street at a high rate of speed. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the motorcycle by the description given.
4/18	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Deputies located a vehicle parked in the lot of Fantasy Island during the late evening hours. The occupants were located nearby and advised by Patrol.
4/18	Grand Island Blvd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies responded to a report of a vehicle that lost a wheel near the traffic circle. The vehicle was towed from the roadway.
4/19	Waterford Pk.	Youth Activity	The complainant states that several youths appeared to be having a party at a nearby address during the late hours of the night. Deputies located several subjects in the area and advised them to keep the noise down.
4/19	Schutt Ct.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a door to a nearby residence was open and it did not appear that anyone was home. Deputies checked the residence but found no persons or sign of a disturbance inside. The door was determined to be an oversight.
4/20	Stony Point Rd.	Fraud	The complainant states that an unknown person(s) made unauthorized purchases using his credit card at a location in New York City.
4/20	Ransom Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle / Traffic Arrest	An employee of the Dino Mart states that a vehicle was driving in and out of the parking lot for the last few hours. Deputies located the vehicle nearby and their investigation led to the arrest of 22 y/o Jaylen Whitt of Buffalo for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions. Whitt was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
4/20	Grand Island Blvd.	Larceny	An employee of Island Pets and Feed states that she noticed money was missing from the cash register but was unsure who might have taken it.
4/21	Bedell Rd.	Property Found	The complainant states he found a bicycle in Veterans Park and it appeared no one was around. Deputies took custody of the bicycle and transported it to the Grand Island Substation awaiting an owner to come forward.
4/21	Bedell Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that his vehicle was being worked on in an auto shop, and while it was in the garage another subject stole the catalytic converter from the vehicle according to a witness. Investigation Ongoing.
4/21	Grand Island Blvd.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 23 y/o Eduardo Arroyo of Buffalo for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his license was currently suspended. Arroyo was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
4/21	Staley Rd.	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a vehicle was driving recklessly down the road. The complainant was able to obtain a plate number for the vehicle. Deputies located the vehicle nearby and issued several tickets to the driver.
4/21	Ransom Rd.	Accident Hit & Run	The complainant states that his parked vehicle was

			struck by an unknown vehicle while in the Grand Island High School lot. No injuries were reported.
4/21	I-190	Drunk Driving / Narcotics Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 44 y/o Leon Alston of Niagara Falls for Driving While Intoxicated, 2 counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 7 th Degree (Class A Misdemeanor)m Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 2 nd Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions. Alston registered a .09% B.A.C. after submitting a sample of his breath for chemical analysis. Alston was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court and released to the custody of a sober 3 rd party.
4/22	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that during the previous night, a dark colored vehicle pulled into his business parking lot and 2 subjects got out of the car and began to walk around the property. The subjects fled in the vehicle after being confronted by a neighbor. No damage was observed and nothing was reported stolen.
4/22	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a vehicle was observed parked in different spots of the lot of the Grand Island Plaza during the course of several hours. Deputies checked and determined the vehicle belonged to an employee of the Laundry Lounge.
4/23	Love Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that her daughters backpack was stolen sometime during the day while at Kaegabine Elementary School by an unknown person(s).
4/23	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	The complainant states that a male subject was sitting in a parked vehicle in the lot of the Grand Island Plaza for the past several hours. Deputies spoke with the subject who stated he was just listening to music and reading books.
4/23	Love Rd.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that an unknown person(s) slashed her tires while her car was parked at Say Cheese during the late hours of the night.
4/24	South State Pkwy	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 38 y/o Alejandro Calderon of Niagara Falls for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his license was currently suspended. Calderon was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
