

Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 181 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

4/30	I-190	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that a vehicle was traveling the wrong way on the I-190. Deputies checked the area but found no vehicles driving in the wrong direction.
4/30	I-190	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 34 y/o Carson Quantrell of Buffalo for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 2 nd Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his license was currently suspended. Quantrell was transported to the Erie County Holding Center in lieu of \$250 bail.
4/30	East River Rd.	Noise Complaint	The complainant states that loud music was coming from a nearby residence. Deputies advised the occupants of the house in question.
4/30	Grand Island Blvd.	Animal Complaint	The complainant states that a suspicious black cat was outside of her window and she needed the police to shoo it away. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the animal.

Accident PDO / Drunk Driving	The complainant states that a vehicle struck the fence in the parking lot of Say Cheese Pizza and then when the driver attempted to flee, he hit another vehicle parked on Blackmon Rd. Deputies located the driver still in the lot of Say Cheese and their investigation led to the arrest of 63 y/o Dennis Donovan of Grand Island for Driving While Intoxicated and other traffic infractions. Donovan registered a .18% B.A.C. after submitting a sample of his breath for chemical analysis and was further charged with Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated due to the elevated reading. Donovan was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court and released to the custody of a sober 3 rd party.
5/2	West River Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a male subject was parked at the overlook during the late hours of the night and appeared to be confused. Deputies located the male subject and assisted him in getting home.
5/2	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	The complainant states that a male subject drove into the parking lot of her apartment complex during the late hours of the night, got out of his vehicle and began to

5/2	Ward Park	Noise Complaint	The complainant states that a vehicle constantly drives through the neighborhood with a loud sound system and wanted increased checks by Patrol.
5/3	Whitehaven Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident near the entrance to the I-190. No injuries were reported.
5/4	Riverdale Dr.	Animal Loose	The complainant states a dog was running loose in the neighborhood and the issue was an ongoing problem. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
5/4	Stony Point Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject was walking on the road dressed in all black with his hands in the air during the late hours of the night. Deputies located the male subject nearby and advised him.

When the complainant confronted the subject, he returned to the vehicle and fled the area. Deputies checked but were unable to locate the vehicle/subject by the description given.
