The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 187 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

| 5/2 | Stony Point Rd. | Suspicious Person | The complainant states that a male subject was laying om the side of the road and appeared to be highly intoxicated. Deputies located the subject nearby who stated he was waiting for a friend to pick him up. |
| 5/2 | Bedell Rd. | Criminal Mischief | The complainant states that sometime in recent nights, an unknown person(s) broke limbs off of a new tree. It appeared the damage may have been done by an animal. |
| 5/2 | Ransom Rd. | Suspicious Incident | Deputies received a call from Onstar stating that a vehicle had an emergency activation button sounding. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given. |
| 5/2 | Bedell Rd. | ATV Operation | The complainant states she heard a dirt bike or an ATV speeding in the area. Deputies checked the area but found no ATV's speeding. |
| 5/3 | Grand Island Blvd. | Suspicious Person with Vehicle | Deputies located a suspicious vehicle parked in the Fantasy Island Parking lot during the late hours of the night. It was determined the occupant of the vehicle was conducting maintenance on some of the attractions. |
| 5/3 | Grand Island Blvd. | Suspicious Incident | The complainant states that it appeared 2 parents were getting high in their vehicle while their child was playing inside the McDonald's Play Place. Deputies located the 2 subjects and determined the complaint was unfounded. |
| 5/3 | Baseline Rd. | Trespass | The complainant states that several youths went into a vacant house yesterday. Deputies checked the premise and found no signs that the house had been entered. |
| 5/3 | Grand Island Blvd. | Property Found | The complainant states he found a bicycle on the side of Tops. The owner was located and the property was returned. |
| 5/3 | Alvin Rd. | Suspicious Vehicle | The complainant states she could see the headlights of a vehicle in the parking lot of Fucillo Hyundai during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked and determined the vehicle was completing a late night delivery of vehicles. |
| 5/3 | Queens Dr. | Suspicious Person with Vehicle | The complainant states that a vehicle was parked in the street with its headlights on during the late hours of the |

| 5/4 | Huth Rd. | Criminal Mischief | The complainant states that several youths were trespassing on the Huth Rd. Elementary School during the previous day and caused minor damage to the building. Investigation Ongoing. |
| 5/4 | Staley Rd. | Wires Down | Deputies responded to a report of wires down and arcing on the ground. National Grid was notified. |
| 5/4 | Ferry Rd. | Larceny | The complainant states that sometime during the weekend an unknown person(s) stole the license plates off of his vehicle. |
| 5/5 | Ferry Rd. | Open Door | Deputies discovered an open door to a closed business during the late hours of the night. A search of the premise was conducted but no persons or signs of a disturbance were observed. The door was re-secured by Patrol. |
| 5/5 | Bishops Gate Rd. | Suspicious Person | The complainant states a male subject was pacing back and forth in the street and appeared to be looking into houses. Deputies located the male subject nearby and determined he was waiting for his school bus. |
| 5/6 | Whitehaven Rd. | Suspicious Incident | The complainant states he believes a co-worker was stealing money from the register. The manager of the store was unable to determine if anything was taken at the time. |
| 5/6 | Grand Island Blvd. | Reckless Operation | The complainant states that a vehicle was being operated recklessly while driving down the road. The vehicle then pulled into SCAP. Deputies located the vehicle in the parking lot of the business and advised the driver. |
| 5/6 | Foxcroft St. | Suspicious Incident | The complainant states that a door was unlocked to a vacant house and believed someone may have been inside recently. The complainant locked and closed the door prior to calling 911. Deputies checked the exterior of the residence and found no signs the house had been entered. |
| 5/6 | Bedell Rd. | Welfare Check | Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call. Deputies spoke with the occupants and determined the call was a misdial. |
| 5/7 | Grand Island Blvd. | Suspicious Incident | An employee of Tops states that a male subject came into the pharmacy section and left a suspicious device on the counter before leaving the store. Deputies secured a small portion of the store. The Erie County Sheriff's Office Bomb Squad responded to the scene and determined the device was not a hazard. |
| 5/8 | Ransom Rd. | Traffic Arrest / Warrant Arrest | Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 40 y/o Anthony Diamond of Grand Island for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his license was currently suspended. Diamond was also found to have an outstanding Arrest Warrant from the Town of Cheektowaga. Diamond was transported to the Erie County Holding Center in lieu of \$250 bail. |
| 5/8 | Whitehaven Rd. | Warrant Arrest | Deputies arrested 29 y/o Christopher Jett of Buffalo on an outstanding Arrest Warrant after the New York State |
