05/02	Suspicious Vehicle	Huth Rd.	Deputies investigated a report of a suspicious vehicle. The vehicle was located, and the occupants were identified and interviewed. The driver and family were parked to stargaze in the area due to less light pollution.
05/04	DWI/Alcohol	I-190 @ Long Rd.	Deputies stopped a vehicle for observed traffic violation(s). After investigation and interview the driver was arrested for DWI. A breath test returned a Blood Alcohol Content of 0.14%, nearly twice the legal limit. The driver was processed and released to a sober third party. The vehicle was placed under a twelve-hour hold.
05/05	Suspicious Vehicle	E. River Rd.	Deputies investigated a report of a suspicious vehicle in the roadway. Deputies located the vehicle stopped across the roadway partially blocking traffic. Investigation located the owner. It appears the vehicle rolled out of the driveway and into the street. The owner retrieved the vehicle and secured it in the driveway.
