



## Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 179 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
5/4	Center Court S	Suspicious Person	Complainant states that she was awoken by an unknown male subject trying to open her apartment door. The male did not make entry and left prior to the arrival of Patrol. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subject. No damage was observed.
5/4	East River Rd.	Suspicious Person	Complainant states that he observed 2 subjects get dropped off by a vehicle in his driveway and it appeared the subjects then entered his backyard. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subjects.
5/4	Love Rd.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 44 y/o Paul Matthews of Buffalo after a DMV check showed his license was currently suspended. Matthews was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 2 <sup>nd</sup> Degree and other traffic infractions. Matthews was transported to the Erie County Holding Center in lieu of \$250 bail.
5/4	South State Pkwy.	Suspicious Person	Complainant states that a subject was riding on a skateboard and appeared to be dressed in full hunting gear. Deputies located the youth subject and advised him.
5/4	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	Complainant states that a female driver began to yell obscenities at her and then drove off in an unknown direction. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle.
5/4	Love Rd.	Fireworks Use	An anonymous complainant stated that youths in the area were using fireworks. Deputies checked the area and determined the complaint to be unfounded.
5/4	Baseline Rd.	Loud Music	Complainant states that she could hear loud music coming from somewhere in the neighborhood. Deputies checked the area and determined the complaint to be unfounded.
5/4	Blue Jay La.	Loud Music	Complainant states that loud music was coming from a

			party in the neighborhood. Deputies spoke to the occupants of the residence in question and advised them to turn down the music.
5/4	Love Rd.	Loud Music	Complainant states that loud music was coming from Say Cheese Pizza. Deputies spoke to employees and advised them to turn down the music.
5/5	Timberlink Dr.	Loud Music	Complainant states that loud music was coming from a residence in the neighborhood. Deputies spoke to the occupants of the residence in question and advised them to turn down the music.
5/5	Whitehaven Rd.	Disorderly Person	Employees of the Holiday Inn state that a patron was causing a disturbance in the parking lot and appeared to be intoxicated. Deputies located the subject and escorted him back to his hotel room without further incident.
5/5	Enola Rd.	ATV Operation	Complainant states that an ATV was riding up and down the street during the late hours of the night. Deputies located the ATV parked at a nearby residence and advised the occupants.
5/5	Bedell Rd.	Neighbor Dispute	Complainant states a neighbor in his apartment complex was yelling at him. Deputies located and advised all parties involved.
5/5	Grand Island Blvd.	Customer Trouble	Employees at Tim Hortons state that a subject came into the restaurant and was causing a disturbance. The subject left prior to the arrival of Patrol but employees were able to get a license plate number to his vehicle. Deputies located the subject at his residence and advised him.
5/5	East River Rd.	ATV Operation	Complainant states that 2 ATV's were driving in the roadway. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the ATV's.
5/5	Grand Island Blvd.	Animal Complaint	Complainant states that a dog was tied to a tree with no food or water and appeared to be in distress. Deputies located the animal, which appeared to be in good health, and advised the owner.
5/5	Ward Park Rd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call. The occupant stated that he was trying to dial a long distance area code and dialed 911 by mistake.
5/5	Grand Island Blvd.	Marijuana Possession	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 2 Juvenile Offenders for Unlawful Possession of Marijuana (Violation) and a traffic infraction. The Juvenile Offenders were issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
5/6	Baseline Rd.	Suspicious Incident	Complainant states that several protestors were close to the street and appeared to be impeding traffic. Deputies located the protestors and advised them.
5/6	Marjorie Dr.	Residential Burglary	Complainant states that sometime during night an unknown person(s) stole various items from her residence. Investigation Ongoing.
5/6	Fix Rd.	Reckless Operation	Complainant states that a motorcycle was speeding down the street. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the motorcycle.
5/6	Baseline Rd.	Suspicious Incident	Complainant states that loud music was coming from Dick and Jennys Bake and Brew Restaurant but it did not

			appear that the business was open. Deputies spoke to employees on the premises that were closing up for the night.
5/7	Marjorie Dr.	Barking Dog	Complainant states that a dog was barking in the neighborhood during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any barking dogs.
5/7	Staley Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
5/7	Fix Rd.	Larceny	Complainant states that he returned home from a trip and noticed numerous items missing from his home. Erie County Sheriff's Office Detectives investigation led to the arrest of 2 Juvenile Offenders from Grand Island. One Juvenile Offender was charged with Grand Larceny 4 <sup>th</sup> Degree (Class E Felony) and Criminal Mischief 4 <sup>th</sup> Degree (Class A Misdemeanor). The second Juvenile Offender was charged with Grand Larceny 4 <sup>th</sup> Degree (Class E Felony), Criminal Mischief 4 <sup>th</sup> Degree (Class A Misdemeanor), Obstruction of Governmental Administration 2 <sup>nd</sup> Degree (Class A Misdemeanor), Resisting Arrest (Class A Misdemeanor), Disorderly Conduct (Violation) and Escape 2 <sup>nd</sup> Degree (Class E Felony). Both Juvenile Offenders were transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending their arraignment in the Town of Grand Island Court.
5/7	West Oakfield Rd.	Parking Violation	Complainant states that a vehicle was parked in the traffic circle on the street. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any vehicles in violation of parking ordinances.
5/7	I-190	Reckless Operation	Complainant states that a vehicle was swerving in and out of traffic. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle.
5/7	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
5/7	Grand Island Blvd.	Disturbance	Complainant states there was a group of people arguing in the parking lot of the Chateau Motor Lodge. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any subjects involved.
5/8	Alvin Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	Complainant states that a vehicle was parked in the Fucillo Chevrolet parking lot with its lights on during the late hours of the night. Deputies located the vehicle which belonged to a landscaping company that was completing work on the property.
5/9	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
5/9	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident Hit & Run	Complainant states that while she was at work an unknown vehicle struck her parked car and caused damage.
5/9	South State Pkwy.	Youth Activity	Complainant states several youths were seen on the South State Pkwy overpass to the I-190. Deputies located the youths who were walking home from a local business.
5/10	Whitehaven Rd.	Reckless Operation	Complainant states a vehicle was swerving in and out of

			lanes on the I-190 then exited onto the Whitehaven Rd. exit and left in an unknown direction. Deputies located the vehicle and advised the driver.
5/10	Stony Point Rd.	Drunk Driving	<p>Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 65 y/o Holly Richards of Grand Island for Driving While Intoxicated. Richards registered a .26% B.A.C. after submitting a sample of her breath for chemical analysis. Richards was charged with Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated due to the elevated B.A.C. reading and Felony Driving While Intoxicated due to a DWI conviction in the previous 10 years. Richards was transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending her arraignment in the Town of Grand Island Court.</p>
5/10	East Park Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	<p>Complainant states that a vehicle was parked on the street with its lights on and no one appeared to be around it. Deputies located the owner and determined the vehicle had run out of gas.</p>
