The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 151 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

4/20	South State Pkwy	Reckless Operation	Complainant states that a vehicle was stopping in traffic while travelling on South State Pkwy. Deputies located the vehicle at the registered owner's address and advised the driver.
4/20	White Oak Te.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	Complainant states that a suspicious vehicle parked on the street and a subject exited the car and ran from house to house through the front yards. Deputies located the vehicle and determined it was the Buffalo News Delivery Person on his normal route.
4/20	Whitehaven Rd.	Wire Down	Complainant states that wires were hanging about 8 feet off the ground. Deputies were unable to locate any low hanging wires.
4/20	Ward Park Rd.	Suspicious Incident	Complainant states that she could smell the odor of burnt marijuana in the area. Deputies checked but were unable to locate any subjects using the substance.
4/20	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Incident	Complainant states that she believed an adult had just purchased alcohol for teens that were waiting in the parking lot at a local store. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any subjects involved.
4/20	Whitehaven Rd.	Unlawful Possession of Marijuana	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested a Juvenile Offender for Unlawful Possession of Marijuana (Violation). The Juvenile Offender was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
4/21	Grand Island Blvd.	Drunk Driving	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 27 y/o Nicholas Lafaro for Driving While Intoxicated and various traffic infractions. Lafaro registered a .11% B.A.C. after submitting a sample of his breath for chemical analysis. Lafaro was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court and released to a sober 3 rd party.

4/21	Staley Rd.	Animal Loose	in the neighborhood. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
4/21	Baseline Rd.	Accident Hit & Run	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. One of the vehicles involved fled the scene prior to the arrival of Patrol. No injuries were reported.
4/21	Grand Island Blvd.	Larceny	Employees at Tops state that a subject left the store without paying for groceries. The subject entered his vehicle and fled once approached by the employees. The groceries were recovered. Investigation Ongoing.

4/22	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
4/22	Lakeview Te.	Suspicious Incident	Complainant states that she heard her apartment door open and then heard someone enter the apartment. Deputies located several subjects outside the apartment that had knocked on the wrong apartment door and opened the door by accident.

Deputies received a call from a complainant about a suspicious vehicle located on Garden Pkwy moments later and responded to find the stolen vehicle with no subjects around it. 4/24	Beaver Island State Park	Trespass	Deputies responded to a report of a suspicious vehicle in Beaver Island State Park. Deputies investigation led to the arrests of 21 y/o Sean Price of North Tonawanda, 22 y/o David Price of North Tonawanda, 20 y/o Travis Compeau of North Tonawanda, 20 y/o Christopher Persechino of North Tonawanda, and 21 y/o Dmitri Novik of Kenmore for Trespass (Violation). Price and Jones were transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending arraignment in the Town of Grand Island Court. The remaining subjects were issued appearance tickets returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
