The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 189 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

5/9	Deerwood La.	Loud Music	The complainant states that loud music was coming from a nearby party during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked the area and determined the music was coming from a concert across the river somewhere in Tonawanda.
5/9	Beaver Island State Park	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	Deputies located a suspicious vehicle parked in Beaver Island State Park during the late hours of the night. The occupants were advised and left without incident.

5/9	Ward Park	Open Burn Complaint	The complainant states that a nearby neighbor was burning trash and causing a hazard in the area. Deputies located the subject and advised him.
5/9	Whitehaven Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident in the parking lot of Byblos Niagara Resort & Spa. No injuries were reported.
5/10	East River Rd.	Suspicious Person	Deputies located 2 subjects at Fisherman's Landing during the late hours of the night. The subjects were

			advised and left without incident.
5/10	Grand Island Blvd.	Disorderly Person	An employee of KOA campground states that a patron of the campground was asked numerous times to follow the rules of the park and refused to do so. Employees asked told the subject she was no longer welcome and asked her to leave the premise to which she also refused and began to use profane language. Deputies investigation resulted in the arrest of 45 y/o Ellana Eberhardt of Williamsville for Disorderly Conduct (Violation) and Trespassing (Violation). Eberhardt was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
5/10	Grand Island Blvd.	Trespass	Several hours after the initial report of the above incident, employees of KOA campground state that the subject returned. Deputies located the subject Eberhardt who was charged with another count of Trespassing (Violation) and transported to the Erie County Holding Center in lieu of \$100 bail.
5/10	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that several subjects were in a vehicle parked in front of Family Dollar and appeared to be smoking marijuana. The vehicle left prior to the arrival of Patrol. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
5/10	Whitehaven Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
5/10	Grand Island Blvd.	Larceny	The complainant states that while he was at Fantasy Island an unknown person stole his wallet.
5/10	Grand Island	Suspicious Incident	Deputies received a call from the Buffalo Air Traffic Control tower that an unknown person(s) somewhere on Grand Island were shining green lasers at aircraft. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any subjects involved.

5/11	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	Deputies located an individual soliciting for money in front of Tim Hortons. The subject was advised of the town code prohibiting the act and he left without incident.

5/13	Lang Blvd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a 911 hang up call from a local business. Deputies spoke with employees on location and determined the call was a mistake.
5/13	Bishops Gate Rd.	Fraud	The complainant states that an unknown person(s) stole various checks at an unknown time.
5/13	South State Pkwy.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
5/14	Baseline Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.

5/15	Queens Dr.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a vehicle was parked in front of his residence for several hours during the late hours of the night. Deputies located the occupant nearby and advised him.

5/15	Bedell Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Deputies located 2 unoccupied vehicles parked behind the Grand Island Memorial Library during the late hours of the night. No persons were observed in the area.
5/15	Tracey La.	Youth Activity	The complainant states that 4 kids attempted to take something off of her front porch before she scared them away. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the youths. Nothing was reported stolen or
