The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 291 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

Date	Type	Street	Narrative
5/15	DWI/Alcohol	Northwest Savings Bank lot	Deputies were called abut a suspicious male operating a vehicle in the parking lot of the Northwest Savings Bank. The vehicle left the parking lot and deputies located the vehicle a short time later. The operator was determined to be intoxicated by alcohol and was taken to the Grand Island substation to be processed. The subject registered a BAC of .31% (almost four times the legal limit). He was arrested and processed for aggravated DWI and transported to ECMC for medical attention on MHL 22.09 due to his extreme intoxication.
5/17	Suspicious Vehicle	West River Rd. @ Sunset Dr.	Deputies were called to investigate a driver that appeared to be slumped over the wheel of a vehicle in the roadway. Deputies arrived and as they approached the vehicle the driver drove off nearly striking a deputy. The vehicle fled at a high rate of speed and a vehicle pursuit was deemed unsafe for the public. The vehicle was last observed driving north on the north bridge into Niagara Falls. The owner of the vehicle was identified through prior booking photos and has a warrant and a suspended license. Deputies will investigate further and attempt contact at a later date.
5/18	Disturbance / Warrant Arrest	Bedell Rd.	A complainant reported that there is a male banging on her door and trying to break in. Complainant stated that the known male has a warrant. Deputies arrived and detained the male who was confirmed to have three outstanding warrants from various jurisdictions. A Domestic Incident Report was completed for the incident and the male was arrested and taken to the ECHC held pending arraignment for his warrants.
