

## **Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary**

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 222 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **<u>Grand Island</u>**.

5/14	Baseline Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a vehicle was in front of his residence with the 4 ways on during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.

Pendrys was transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending his arraignment in the Town of Grand Island Court.
5/19	Brandywine Dr.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a vehicle was driving around the area and appeared to be collecting scrap metal, but there was a female passenger inside who appeared to be crying. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
5/20	Bedell Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject was walking around in the area taking pictures and thought he was up to no good. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the male by the description given.
5/20	East River Rd.	Youth Activity	The complainant states that some youths were on private docks in the area and were trespassing. Deputies located a youth and advised her. She left without incident.
