Date	Type	Street	Narrative
5/17/2026	ATV-Operate/Street	Carter Dr.	A group was informed that they could not operate a go cart or dirt bike on the public roadway.
5/18/2026	Disturbance – Public Place	Oakfield Rd.	Patrol assisted New York State Parks Police with an altercation involving three individuals in Beaver Island State Park.
5/18/2026	Accident – PDO	Alt Blvd. at Fix Rd.	A school bus and car collided in the listed intersection. There were no students on the bus at the time of the crash. The operator of the car was ticketed for failing to stop and yield at the intersection.

5/22/2026	Property Found	Staley Rd.	A complainant turned a dash cam that she found into patrol. The device was stored in a property locker for safekeeping.
