The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 340 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

Date	Туре	Street	Narrative
5/30	Traffic Stop – Warrant Arrest	I-190@ Long Rd.	Deputies initiated a traffic stop on a red Chevrolet Silverado on the I-190 in Grand Island. The driver, Justin Say (25), was identified by his NYS license and found to have an active warrant out of the Town of Lockport. Justin was issued a UTT and turned over to Lockport PD.
5/31	Mental	Marlin Ct.	Deputies responded to a 21 year old son having a meltdown. Deputies spoke with son and parents and determined that the son was having an episode of paranoia with his parents. Mom is going to take the son to the hospital for evaluation.
5/31	Mental	Grand Island Bd	Deputies went to apartments to check on a daughter threatening suicide according to mother. Deputies evaluated the daughter and decided that she needed to go see someone at the hospital. She was transported to ECMC CPEP on MHL 9.41.
6/1	Accident - PDO	Tim Horton's	Deputies were called to Tim Horton's for a rear end accident in the drive thru. Deputies were soon informed that the striking vehicle did not stay and that the other driver followed the vehicle to Town Hall Terrace Apts. Deputies located both driver's and did a report. The striking driver was issued two UTT's for the accident.
6/1	Disturbance Other	West River Rd.	Deputies were called by female reporting that her boyfriend just smashed a door. Deputies arrived on scene to find that the male had left and that the female had a wrist injury and some redness to her face. Report was completed and female was evaluated by EMS. Deputies attempted to contact male via phone with negative results. A warrant will be requested for his arrest.
6/1	Mental	East River Rd.	Deputies were contacted by male stating that his nephew is suicidal and heading to the Grand Island Bridge to hang himself. Deputies immediately checked both bridges with negative results. Shortly later deputies located the subject and he was transported to ECMC for evaluation.
6/3	Mental	Long Rd.	Deputies responded to a residence for a son that says he's cutting his wrists. Deputies spoke with parents and subject. Son did not want to go with dad so he threatened to hurt himself. Mom is going to get him evaluated on her own.

6/4	Mental	East River Rd.	Deputies responded for a female possible overdose on medications. Deputies found the subject semi-conscious and it appears she was trying to harm herself. She was transported to ECMC on MHL 9.41 by patrol.
