

## **Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary**

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 181 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Evert registered a .15% B.A.C. after submitting a sample of his breath for chemical analysis. Evert was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court and released to the custody of a sober 3 <sup>rd</sup> party.
