| 05/31 | Traffic Infraction | Grand Island Bd. | Deputies initiated a traffic stop for observed traffic infraction(s). Through interview and investigation, it was determined that the driver had a suspended license. The subject was received multiple traffic tickets. |
| 06/01 | DWI/Alcohol | Whitehaven Rd. | Deputies initiated a traffic stop for observed traffic infraction(s). After investigation and interview the driver was arrested for DWI. The driver was processed and released to a sober third-party and the vehicle was placed under a twelvehour hold. |
| 06/01 | Criminal Mischief | River Run | Deputies responded to a report from a complainant that witnessed their neighbor's door being kicked in. Deputies found the door damaged and interviewed the victim. Investigation ongoing by the detective bureau. |
| 06/03 | DWI/Alcohol | E. River Rd. | Deputies responded to a report of a single vehicle accident. After investigation and interview the driver was arrested for DWI. The driver registered a B.A.C. of 0.15%, nearly twice the legal limit. The subject was sent for evaluation, and the vehicle was placed on a twelve-hour hold. |
