The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 289 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

Date	Type	Street	Narrative
6/5	Larceny/ Warrant Arrest	East River Rd.	Deputies were called to a jobsite on East River Rd. for a worker yelling at foreman after being terminated. Deputies arrived and spoke with the parties to find that the terminated employee had stolen some property. Upon confirming the subject's identity, he was found to also have an active warrant out of Niagara. Subject was arrested for the theft as well as false impersonation. He was taken to the ECHC pending arraignment.
6/8	Suspicious Incident	Maguire Chevrolet	Deputies were called to an unknown male going through vehicles at the dealership. The manager reported that he observed a man on camera entering and exiting vehicles and that the dealership is closed. Deputies located the subject across the street, and he did not have any stolen property on his persons. The manager checked and the vehicles were all in order. Subject advised not to trespass.
6/8	Criminal Mischief	Huth Rd Elementary	Deputies responded to a call of youths at the school just before midnight shooting off fireworks. Deputies arrived and located several youths and cans of spray paint and fireworks. All juveniles were documented and turned over to their parents. School will be notified for any possible charges.
6/9	Domestic Trouble	Chateau Motor Lodge	Deputies were called to a disturbance. After speaking with both parties, it was discovered that one party had an active warrant out of Orchard Park. The subject was detained and turned over to Orchard Park PD and a domestic incident report was completed.
6/11	Traffic Infraction Other	Grand Island BD.	Deputies received a call from a driver claiming that a vehicle pulled up next to him and the driver yelled at him and. The suspect showed up at the substation a few minutes later to report the same incident. At that time deputies discovered that the the driver had 16 suspensions including many for failing to appear to court. The driver was arrested and taken to the ECHC pending arraignment.
