The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 292 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

Date	Type	Street	Narrative
6/13	Larceny	Certified Auto Brokers	Deputies responded to Certified Auto Brokers for wheels and tires taken off a vehicle overnight. Sometime Saturday night three persons were seen on camera attempting to enter the facility. They were unable to gain entrance but did proceed to take the wheels and tires off of a Toyota in the lot. Case will be handled by the Detective Bureau.
6/14	Vandalism	Walgreen's and Tim Horton's	Deputies responded to Walgreens and Tim Hortons for vandalism done to the bathrooms at the businesses. Video shows three youth's but they are covered in hoodies and masks. Incident is under investigation.
6/15	Disturbance Other	Love Rd.	Deputies were called by a resident on Love Rd. in regards to a roofing contractor threatening him. Deputies arrived to find both parties in disagreement over the work done and refusal to pay. Parties were advised that their civil issue would need to be addressed at Grand Island Court. Contractor left without further incident.
6/16	Suspicious Person(s)	East River Rd. @ I-190	Deputies were called to under the North Grand Island Bridge for two suspicious males leaning over the guard rail. Deputies arrived and located the two males on Long Rd. After identifying them they were both found to have outstanding warrants and were turned over to Lackawanna PD and Amherst PD respectively.
6/17	Larceny from Vehicle	Waterford Park, Park Place, and Staley Rd.	Deputies were called to males in a black Mercedes going through vehicle's on Waterford Park. Deputies searched the area but the vehicle and males left the island. Shortly later several calls came in two of which were vehicle's taken from residences on Park Place. The vehicle's were unlocked and the keys were in them.
