Date	Type	Street	Narrative
6/13/2026	Parking Violation	Bedell Rd.	An individual working an event at Veterans Park reported parking was out of control. Deputies responded and observed handicapped parking spots being blocked and misused. One ticket was issued because no handicap tag was displayed.
6/15/2026	Larceny – From Vehicle	Stony Point Rd.	Multiple unlocked vehicles at multiple addresses on the listed street were broken into during the overnight hours. Various items were reported to be missing.
6/16/2026	Attempt to Locate	White Lak La.	A caller reported her husband left their residence earlier in the day and hadn't returned. Patrol located the man approximately six miles away.
