7/4/2026	Disturbance Other	Grand Island Blvd.	Patrol responded to McDonald's after a terminated employee refused to leave the premises.
7/4/2026	Accident – PDO	E. River Rd.	A vehicle backed into a mailbox, causing minor damage to the vehicle.
7/6/2026	Assist Person	E. River Rd.	Patrol assisted in resolving a dispute over compensation for docking a boat at River Oaks Marina.
