The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 197 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

7/5	Grand Island Blvd.	Loud Music	The complainant states loud music was coming from a nearby motel during the late hours of the night. Deputies located the source of the music and advised the occupants.
7/5	East River Rd.	Loud Music	The complainant states that loud music was coming from a boat that was docked at Turners Port of Call during the late hours of the night. The occupants of the boat were advised.

Nelligan was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
7/7	Love Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	Deputies located a suspicious vehicle parked at Kaegabine Elementary School during the late evening hours. The Driver was advised and left without incident.

7/9	Bedell Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that an intoxicated male subject was harassing the lifeguards at the pool in the Country Glen Apartment Complex. Deputies located the subject and advised him.
7/9	Long Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.

7/11	Grand Island Blvd.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 33 y/o Alexander Tigg of Buffalo for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 2 nd Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his license was currently revoked. Tigg was issued an appearance ticket

			returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
7/11	Stony Point Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) stole an unsecured bicycle from his yard.
