



## Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 192 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

6/20	Havenwood La.	Shots Fired	The complainant states that she heard several shots in the area during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked the area and determined the complaint was unfounded.

Novkov was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.

6/22	Grand Island Blvd.	Narcotics / Warrant Arrest	Deputies responded to a report of a female slumped over the wheel at Tim Hortons. Their investigation led to the arrest of 29 y/o Amanda Ingram of Grand Island for Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 7 <sup>th</sup> Degree (Class A misdemeanor). Ingram was also found to have an outstanding warrant from the City of Buffalo. Ingram was transferred to the custody of the Buffalo Police Department.

Erie County Sheriff's Deputies and Detectives investigation led to the arrest of 47 y/o Jonathan Beckman of Niagara Falls for Grand Larceny 3 <sup>rd</sup> Degree (Class D Felony) and Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 3 <sup>rd</sup> Degree (Class D Felony). Beckman was transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending his arraignment in the Town of Grand Island Court.

6/23	East River Rd.	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported.
