



Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

Dates: 7/21/2012 to 7/27/2012

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 195 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

| 7/22 | Whitehaven Rd. | Shots Fired | Complainant states a subject was target shooting at a residence on Whitehaven Rd. Deputies located the subject and advised him of the Town of Grand Island ordinance regarding discharging firearms. |
| 7/22 | East River Rd. | Residential Burglary | Complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) broke into her residence and attempted to steal items. At the time of the report, no items were reported as missing. Investigation Ongoing. |
| 7/22 | Schwegler Rd | Fireworks Use | Complainant states that fireworks were being used in the area. Deputies checked but were unable to locate any subjects using fireworks. |
| 7/23 | Ransom Rd. | Suspicious Vehicle | Deputies located a suspicious vehicle parked in the lot of Dino Mart late at night. Deputies advised the subjects who left without incident. |

| 7/25 | Grand Island Blvd. | Larceny | Complainant states that sometime during recent days, an unknown person(s) stole various items from outside of his business. Investigation Ongoing. |
| 7/25 | Grand Island Blvd. | Disorderly Person | Employees at Fantasy Island state a subject inside the |

| 7/25 | Ferry Rd. | Larceny | Complainant states that a known individual stole various items from her business. Investigation Ongoing. |
| 7/25 | Fix Rd. | Suspicious Person | Complainant states a suspicious male was sitting on the side of the road. Deputies located the male subject who had a permit to sell items door to door and was taking a break. |
| 7/25 | East River Rd. | Youth Activity | Complainant states that 2 youths with backpacks were riding bicycles on East River Rd. during the late evening hours. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the youths. |
| 7/25 | Love Rd. | Suspicious Incident | Complainant states that a young male subject was attempting to buy beer from Wilson Farms. The subject tried several times but was refused. Deputies were unable to locate the subject, who left prior to Patrols arrival. |

Lacey was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd degree and other traffic infractions. Lacey was released on appearance tickets returnable to Town of Grand Island Court. |
| 7/26 | Harvey Rd. | Parking Violation | Complainant states a moving van was parked near an intersection and was obstructing the view of travelling motorists. Deputies located the van and advised the driver to move the vehicle. |
| 7/26 | Grand Island Blvd. | Larceny | Employee at Sunoco Express stated that a customer became argumentative when his credit card was declined. The subject pushed the employee and before leaving the store, stole some change. Deputies investigation led to the arrest of 50 y/o Lloyd Hill of Grand Island for Petit Larceny (a Class A Misdemeanor) and Harassment 2 nd Degree (a Violation). Lloyd was issued an appearance ticket returnable to Town of Grand Island Court. |
