The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 258 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

7/14	Larceny from Vehicle's	West River Rd. and Veteran's Park	Deputies responded to multiple instances of larcenies from vehicles. Incidents occurred at Woods Creek Park and Veteran's Park. Valuables were left in plain view and windows smashed and items taken from the vehicle. Police Report completed and investigation is ongoing.
7/17	Accident Injury/ DWI Alcohol	South State Pkwy	Deputies responded to a two-vehicle accident at the traffic circle on South State Pkwy. While investigating the accident deputies recognized one of the vehicle operators displaying signs of intoxication. The operator was arrested for DWI and a breath test returned a .19 BAC, nearly two and a half times the legal limit. Accident report completed and the operator was processed and released to a sober third party.
7/20	Suspicious Person	Whitehaven Rd. @ Baseline Rd.	While patrolling the area after 3:00 am deputies noticed a shirtless subject walking in the middle of the street carrying a sword. Upon approach the subject jumped into a ditch to hide. The subject was known to patrol. Patrol confiscated the sword and secured it with a family member. The subject continued his late-night walk.
7/20	Assist Border Patrol	West River Rd.	Deputies were called to assist Border Patrol with a suspected illegal entry crossing the river. Deputies located the contact vehicle that was picking the suspects up. A short time later Deputies located the suspects and detained them for Border Patrol. Erie County Sheriff's Office K9 unit was used for tracking.
