6/22	West Park Rd.	Warrant Arrest	Deputies arrested 43 y/o Brian Ambrusko of Grand Island on a warrant following their investigation of an unrelated complaint.
6/22	Fairview Ct.	Loud Music	Complainant states that loud music was coming from a small gathering somewhere in the area. Deputies checked and determined the complaint to be unfounded.
