The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 354 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

| Date | Type | Street | Narrative |

| 06/19 | Assist Other PD | Wallace Dr | Deputies assisted Lewiston PD looking for 2 wanted subjects. Deputies and Lewiston PD took the subjects into custody without incident. |
| 06/20 | Unwelcome Guest | Grand Island Blvd | Deputies received a call for two subjects who hopped a fence and were trespassing in a restricted area of a closed business. The suspects were located and advised by deputies to stay off the property moving forward as requested by the business. The business did not want charges. |
| 06/21 | Fight | Warner Dr | Deputies received a call about subjects fighting. Upon arrival, parties were separated. Both individuals denied injuries and did not want to pursue any charges. All advised. |
| 06/23 | DWI | Warner Dr | Deputies responded to a complaint of a vehicle repeatedly honking the horn at 2AM. Deputies located the vehicle. After interview and investigation, the driver was charged with DWI. The subject was processed and released to a sober third party and the vehicle was placed under a twelve-hour hold. |
| 6/24 | Shoplifting | Grand Island Blvd | Deputies responded to the report of a subject leaving a business and passing all points of purchase with store merchandise and not paying. The subject was located and arrested, and all items were returned to the business. Upon further investigation it was determined the subject had active warrants out of Niagara County Sheriff's Office, Cheektowaga Police Department, and Town of Niagara Police Department. The subject was held and transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending arraignment and the other police agencies were advised so the warrants could be served. |
