Diamond was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.

7/24	Bedell Rd.	Injury Accident	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. 1 occupant was transported to a local hospital with seemingly minor injuries.		
7/24	Whitehaven Rd.	Shots Fired	The complainant states that he heard several gun shots coming from the wooded area behind the cemetery. Deputies checked the area but did not hear any gun shots.		
7/24	Grand Island Blvd.	Warrant Arrest	Deputies arrested 39 y/o Michael Paul of Grand Island after serving a warrant at his residence. Paul had an outstanding bench warrant issued from the Town of Grand Island and he was transported to the Erie County Holding Center.		
7/24	Ward Park Rd.	Animal Complaint	The complainant states that a neighbor's dog attacked her dog. The Dog Control Officer was notified.		
7/24	Carl Rd.	Fireworks Use	The complainant states that someone in the area was using fireworks for the last several hours. Deputies checked the area but found no one using fireworks.		
7/24	Revere Rd.	Animal Complaint	The complainant states that someone may have taken her dogs while she was in the backyard of her residence. The dogs were found in the garage.		
7/24	Baseline Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that 3 male subjects were hanging around the Grand Island Fire station and then began to walk away in an unknown direction during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subjects. No damage was observed to the premise.
