The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 266 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

6/28	Criminal Mischief	Burger King	Deputies responded to the Burger King parking lot for a larceny of catalytic converters. A contractor working on equipment at Burger King from midnight to 2:30AM found that someone had cut off his catalytic converters. Deputies are securing video and will investigate further.
6/28	Domestic Trouble	Creekside Dr.	Deputies responded to a possible domestic called in by a friend. Deputies investigated the incident and arrested a male on several domestic related charges. He was processed at the station and taken to the ECHC pending arraignment.
6/29	Traffic Stop/OOP Violation	I-190 @ Long Rd.	Deputies initiated a traffic stop on a white Chrysler sedan. After identifying the driver and passenger it was determined that the driver had a suspended license and a stay away order was in place against him by the passenger. The was issued tickets for his violations and arrested for the violation of the OOP. He was processed and transported to the ECHC pending arraignment.
7/1	Accident/Injury	Stonypoint Ext.	Deputies were called to a motorcycle accident under the South Grand Island bridge. The driver of the motorcycle lost control and has a possible broken leg. Driver also had a suspended license. Motorcycle also had the wrong license plate on it. Deputies towed the bike and issued tickets to the driver, who was taken to Kenmore Mercy hospital for his injuries.
7/2	Disturbance Other	Stonypoint Rd.	Deputies were called by mother for her son out of control smashing things. Deputies spoke with both parties and found that there was an order of protection in place by the mother against the son He was arrested for several charges, processed, and transported to the ECHC pending arraignment.
7/3	DWI/Alcohol	South State Pkwy @ I-190	Deputies initiated a traffic stop on a blue Subaru sedan. Driver was found to be intoxicated after field sobriety tests. A male was arrested for DWI, processed, and released to a third party at the Grand Island substation.
7/3	Disturbance Other/Warrant Serve	Ward Park Rd.	Deputies received a call from a neighbor for a male/female disturbance. Deputies arrived and spoke to all parties. Male half was found to have outstanding warrants by deputies. Subject was turned over to Lancaster PD for their warrant. Police report on file.
