



## Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 170 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

6/27	Baseline Rd.	Burglary	Patrol responded to a report of a burglary alarm sounding at an auto repair shop during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked the business and found a broken window. The business was searched but no persons were found inside. Patrol spoke with the owner and together they reviewed the video surveillance footage of the incident which showed a suspect entering the building and fleeing a short time later. A crime scene unit was dispatched and gathered evidence found at the scene. Investigation Ongoing.
6/27	Queens Dr.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
6/27	Fairview Ct.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject was in the woods behind the playground in the neighborhood and then got into a car that was parked on South State Pkwy and left the area. Deputies checked but were unable to locate the male or the vehicle by the description given.
6/27	Calvano Dr.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime during the night an unknown person(s) entered his unlocked vehicle and stole numerous items from inside.
6/27	Baseline Rd.	Residential Burglary	The complainant states that sometime during the night an unknown person(s) entered her unlocked vehicle and stole various items from inside. The subjects also entered an unlocked attached garage and stole a bicycle from inside.
6/27	Greenway Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime during the night an unknown person(s) entered his unlocked vehicle and stole numerous items from inside.
6/27	Webb Rd.	Wires Down	Deputies responded to a report of a tree limb that fell on some wires in the area. National Grid was notified.
6/28	Red Jacket Rd.	Drunk Driving	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 47 y/o Samantha Burris of Grand Island for Driving While Intoxicated and other traffic infractions. Burris registered a .20% B.A.C. after submitting a sample of her breath for chemical analysis and was further charged with Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated due to the

			elevated reading. Burris was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court and released to the custody of a sober 3 <sup>rd</sup> party.
6/28	South State Pkwy.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident near the intersection of Carl Rd. No injuries were reported.
6/28	Warner Dr.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime in recent nights an unknown person(s) entered her unlocked vehicle and stole numerous items from inside.
6/28	South State Pkwy.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject was walking behind some houses in the area and was dressed in all black carrying a duffel bag. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the male by the description given.
6/28	Meadow La.	Weapon Offense	The complainant states that he witnessed a neighbor standing on his rear porch shoot a rabbit in his yard. Deputies investigation led to the arrest of 78 y/o Terry Manning of Grand Island for Illegal Discharge of a Firearm (Misdemeanor). Manning was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court and the weapon used to commit the crime was confiscated by Patrol.
6/28	Sheree Dr.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states several subjects were walking down the street being loud and appeared to be looking into vehicles during the late hours of the night. The complainant yelled at the subjects causing them to flee the area. Deputies checked but were unable to locate the subjects by the descriptions given.
6/29	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
6/29	East River Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a subject was coming thru the woods onto her property and taking photos of her garbage. Deputies spoke with the subject and advised him.
6/29	Stony Point Rd.	Welfare Check	The complainant states that a vehicle was parked on the side of the road near Ransom Rd. and it appeared the driver was in distress. Deputies checked the area and determined the complaint was unfounded.
6/29	Stony Point Rd.	Burglary in Progress	The complainant states that 3 subjects just broke into a neighboring vacant residence. Deputies located the subjects on location and determined they were employees of the property management company securing the residence.
6/29	Grand Island Blvd.	Property Found	The complainant states that he found an ATM card and wanted to turn it over to Patrol. Deputies contacted the owner and the card was returned without incident.
6/29	Morningside Dr.	Youth Activity	The complainant states that several youths were ringing doorbells in the neighborhood and running during the late hours of the night. Deputies located the youths nearby and advised them.
6/30	Fix Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident at the intersection of Baseline Rd. No injuries were reported

6/30	Bedell Rd.	Fireworks Use	The complainant states that someone in the area was using fireworks during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate anyone using fireworks.
7/1	Whitehaven Rd.	Warrant Arrest	Patrol received a call from the Niagara County Sheriff's Office stating that they had a female in custody on a bench warrant from Erie County. Deputies arrested 24 y/o Candice Moses of Collins on the warrant. Moses was transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending her appearance in court.
7/1	Revere Rd.	Trespass	The complainant states that her son found a male subject in their kitchen and chased him out of the residence. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subject by the description given. Investigation Ongoing.
7/2	Alt Blvd.	Residential Burglary	The complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) entered her unlocked attached garage and stole numerous items from 2 vehicles parked inside.
7/2	Grand Island Blvd.	Warrant Arrest	Deputies arrested 27 y/o Troy Getz of North Tonawanda after serving a warrant at his residence. Getz was transferred to the custody of the Town of Tonawanda Police Department.
7/2	East River Rd.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 26 y/o Darryl Caldwell Jr. for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 <sup>rd</sup> Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his license was currently suspended. Caldwell Jr. was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
7/3	Stony Point Rd.	Suspicious Person	Deputies located a male subject skate boarding during the late hours of the night. The subject was advised.
7/3	Whitehaven Rd.	Fire	Deputies assisted the Grand Island Fire Department with a report of a fire at the Grand Island Small Animal Hospital. No injuries were reported to any of the occupants.
7/3	Cardinal La.	ATV Operation Complaint	The complainant states that a neighbor was operating an ATV on his property. Deputies located the subject nearby and advised him.
7/3	Bush Rd.	Animal Loose	The complainant states that 2 dogs were running loose in the neighborhood. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
7/3	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
7/3	Fix Rd.	Fireworks Use	The complainant states that a nearby neighbor was using huge fireworks. Deputies located the residence in question and advised the occupants.
7/3	Bedell Rd.	Fireworks Use	The complainant states that a group of youths were using fireworks on the front lawn of the County Glen Apartments. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the youths.
