



Erie County Sheriff's Office Weekly Blotter

Dates: June 27 – July 3, 2026

The Erie County Sheriff's Office handled 2,151 complaints during the reporting period. This includes:

- **361 premises checks**
- **17 neighborhood patrols**
- **195 traffic stops**
- **265 calls to assist other agencies**
- **36 warrants served**

Dispatch received several firework-related complaints across multiple towns on the night of July 3.

Date	Type	Street	Narrative
6/27/2026	Disturbance Other	Harvey Rd.	Patrol responded to a disturbance during which two individuals became aggressive with each other while playing football. The complainant had cuts on his hand and a mark on his neck but declined first aid.
6/27/2026	Fire Investigation	E. River Rd.	Patrol responded to a residential fire that reportedly started in the garage and spread into the residence. Nobody was in the home, and pets were removed prior to patrol's arrival. The investigation was referred to the Fire Investigation Unit.
6/27/2026	Suspicious Incident	Baseline Rd.	A resident of Baseline Rd. showed patrol a doorbell video of an unknown individual walking up to his front door and looking for a key. The subject then left on foot.
