The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 216 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

7/20	Long Rd.	Wires Down	The complainant states that a transformer in the area had blown up causing the neighborhood to lose power. National Grid was notified.
7/20	East River Rd.	Road Obstruction	The complainant states that a tree was down and blocking the roadway. NITTEC was notified.
7/20	Whitehaven Rd.	Suspicious Person	An employee at Noco states that a male subject was urinating in the parking lot. Deputies located the subject nearby and advised him he was no longer welcome on the property of Noco.

7/20	Fix Rd.	Loud Music	The complainant states that loud music was coming from a nearby residence during the late evening hours. Deputies checked the area and determined the complaint to be unfounded.

7/21	Tracey La.	Fireworks Use	The complainant states that he heard several loud explosions in the area of his residence but was unsure where they were coming from. Deputies checked the area, no more fireworks were heard.
7/21	Bedell Rd.	Loud Music	The complainant states that loud music and possible fireworks were coming from a nearby residence. Deputies located the residence and advised the occupants.
7/21	Love Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) stole various items from her unlocked vehicle.

The subject was transported to a local area hospital with seemingly non-life threatening injuries.

Bloomquist refused to submit a sample of his breath for chemical analysis. Bloomquist was also charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree after a DMV check showed his license was suspended. Bloomquist was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court and released to a sober 3 rd party.

7/22	Grand Island Blvd.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 23 y/o David

			Winter of Grand Island for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree and Operating a Motor Vehicle with a suspended registration. Winter was transported to the Erie County Holding Center in lieu of \$250 bail.
7/22	Alvin Rd.	Larceny	Employees of Fucillo Toyota state that sometime overnight an unknown person(s) stole 4 tires with rims from a vehicle on the sales lot. Erie County Sheriff's Detectives and Deputies investigation led to the arrest of 30 y/o Matthew Misiak of Cheektowaga for Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 4 th Degree (E Felony). Misiak was transported to the Erie County Holding Center in lieu of \$250 bail. Investigation Ongoing.
