



Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 194 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
8/8	Love Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies responded to a report of a disabled motor vehicle in the intersection of South State Pkwy. Deputies checked the area and determined the complaint was unfounded.
8/8	Glen Avon Rd.	Loud Music	The complainant states that loud music was coming from a nearby address on Glen Avon Rd. Deputies checked and determined the complaint was unfounded.
8/8	Grand Island Blvd.	Disorderly Person	Employees of Fantasy Island state that a female subject was cursing and refusing to leave the park as security requested. The female subject left without further incident prior to the arrival of Patrol.
8/8	Revere Rd.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that a known male subject shot a pellet rifle at him after a dispute over money. The pellet missed the complainant but caused damage to his vehicle. Deputies investigation led to the arrest of 2 y/o Jonathan Armitage of Grand Island for Criminal Mischief 4 th Degree (Class A Misdemeanor), Reckless Endangerment 2 nd Degree (Class A Misdemeanor) and Menacing 3 rd Degree (Class B Misdemeanor). Armitage was transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending his arraignment in the Town of Grand Island Court.
8/8	Sheree Dr.	Loud Music	The complainant states that loud music was coming from an address on Sheree Dr. during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked the area and determined the complaint was unfounded.
8/9	Spicer Creek Run	Loud Music	The complainant states that loud music and a lot of yelling was coming from a nearby address during the late hours of the night. Deputies located the source of the noise and advised the occupants.
8/9	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Incident	Employees of Tim Hortons state that a male and female subject were arguing while in the store during the late hours of the night. The subjects left separately prior to the arrival of Patrol. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subjects by the description given.
8/9	Red Jacket Rd.	Residential Burglary	The complainant states she came home from work and

			discovered that an unknown person(s) had broken into her residence sometime in the past few hours. Numerous items were reported stolen and several things damaged. Investigation Ongoing.
8/9	Baseline Rd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call at a local business. Deputies made contact with employees and determined the call was a misdial.
8/9	Winkler Dr.	Shots Fired	The complainant states he heard 3 gun shots in the previous 45 minutes coming from the wooded area behind his residence. Deputies checked but did not hear anymore gun shots.
8/9	West River Rd.	Drunk	The complainant states that a male subject was passed out in the grass and appeared to be intoxicated. Deputies located the subject and were able to reunite him with friends.
8/9	Grand Island Blvd.	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that a black dodge ram was swerving all over the roadway and was last seen headed southbound on Grand Island Blvd. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
8/9	Stony Point Rd.	Animal Loose	The complainant states that a neighbor's dog was loose and running through the neighborhood. The Dog Control Officer was advised.
8/9	Baseline Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that 4 subjects were loitering around the Grand Island Fire Department substation. IT was determined the subjects were at a party next door.
8/9	Lakeview Terr.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a suspicious vehicle was parked at the dead end in the back of the apartment complex. Deputies located the vehicle but were unable to make contact with the owner.
8/10	Love Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that several subjects were in a vehicle in front of 711 smoking weed. Deputies located the subjects and determined the item was just an e-cigarette.
8/10	Bedell Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that sometime in the past few days, an unknown person(s) appeared to have tried to make entry into her residence as she could see handprints on a window. Deputies confirmed that no entry was made and nothing was reported missing or stolen. A CSI unit was dispatched to collect any evidence of the incident.
8/11	Baseline Rd.	Marijuana Possession	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 18 y/o Carlos Taylor of Grand Island for Unlawful Possession of Marijuana (Violation) and several traffic infractions. Taylor was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
8/11	Park Pl.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a suspicious vehicle drove through his neighborhood several times. The complainant was able to obtain a license plate number. Deputies located the vehicle nearby and spoke with the driver but nothing appeared out of order.
8/11	Grand Island Blvd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled near the intersection of Staley Rd.

8/11	Grand Island Blvd.	Larceny	Employees from Tops state that 2 female subjects packed up 2 shopping carts worth of groceries and left the store without paying for the items. When employees approached the subjects in the parking lot, the females got into their car and fled the area. Employees were able to provide a description of the subjects and their vehicle. Erie County Sheriff's Office Detective Bureau is following up the case.
8/11	Wallace Dr.	Animal Complaint	The complainant states that her dog was attacked by a neighbor's dog. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
8/11	Cox Rd.	Animal Complaint	The complainant states that 2 dogs were tied up to a stop sign at the corner of Orchard Rd. with no one around. While on the phone with dispatch, a male subject came and picked up the dogs.
8/11	East River Rd.	Marijuana Possession	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 19 y/o Joseph Jarka of Grand Island for Unlawful Possession of Marijuana (Violation) and several traffic infractions. Jarka was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
8/12	Sunset Dr.	Animal Loose	The complainant states that 2 dogs were running loose in the area. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
8/13	West River Pkwy.	Marijuana Possession	Deputies located a suspicious vehicle on the overlook off of West River Pkwy during the late hours of the night. Their investigation led to the arrest of 19 y/o Adam Missert of Grand Island for Unlawful Possession of Marijuana (Violation). Missert was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
8/13	Staley Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident near the intersection of Grand Island Blvd. No injuries were reported.
8/14	Bush Rd.	Open Door	Deputies discovered an open door at WBEN Towers. The building was searched and no persons were found inside and no damage was found.
8/14	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject was stumbling down the road. Deputies located the subject and determined the complaint to be unfounded.
8/14	Town Hall Terr.	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that a pickup truck was speeding through the apartment complex. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
