The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 142 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

8/10	Waterford Pk.	Larceny	The complainant states that he observed a female subject inside of his neighbor's car possibly stealing from it during the late hours of the night. The female subject left prior to the arrival of Patrol. Deputies located the female subject nearby who was identified by the complainant. The female subject consented to a search of her residence and the investigation by Erie County Sheriff's Office Deputies resulted in the arrest of 42 y/o Shari Pendrys of Grand Island for Criminal Mischief 3 rd Degree (E Felony), 3 counts of Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 4 th Degree (E Felony), 2 counts of Grand Larceny 4 th Degree (E Felony), Possession of Burglar Tools (A misdemeanor), Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 7 th Degree (A misdemeanor), Petit Larceny (A misdemeanor) and Unlawful Possession of Personal Identification Information 3 rd Degree (A Misdemeanor). Pendrys was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court. Further charges are pending.
8/10	West Park Rd.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that sometime during recent months, an unknown person(s) damaged the siding to his residence by shooting a BB gun. Deputies determined the damage to be caused by a neighbor of the complainant. The complainant declined to pursue any charges.
8/10	I-190	Fight	The complainant states that 3 individuals were fighting on the Long Rd. overpass of the I-190. Deputies checked the area and determined the complaint to be unfounded.
8/10	Love Rd.	Traffic Control Device	Deputies located a traffic signal with a burnt out light bulb. NITTEC was notified.
8/10	Driftwood Dr.	Loud Music	The complainant states that loud music was coming from a nearby residence. Deputies checked the area and determined the complaint to be unfounded.

8/11	Fix Rd.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that sometime in recent days, an unknown person(s) damaged his vehicle in an attempt to gain entry. No entry was made and noting was reported stolen. Investigation Ongoing
8/12	West River Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a boat in the river was going back and forth acting suspiciously. Deputies checked but were unable to locate the boat.

8/15	Whitehaven Rd.	Property Found	The complainant states that he found a wallet while at Sunoco and wished to turn it over to Patrol. Deputies attempted to contact the owner of the wallet.

8/16	Carter Dr.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call. Deputies spoke to occupants and determined the call to be a misdial.
8/16	Grand Island Blvd.	Reckless Operation	The complaint states that a vehicle was speeding down the street. Deputies checked but were unable to locate the vehicle.
8/16	Warner Dr.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call. Deputies spoke to occupants and determined the call to be a misdial.
