Date	Type	Street	Narrative
8/15/2026	Fraud	Jen Ct.	Patrol completed a police report for a complainant who reported a fraudulent charge on their bank account.
8/16/2026	Suspicious Person	Baseline Rd. at Grand Island Blvd.	A male was reportedly showering himself with a hose at the listed intersection. Patrol responded and advised the subject to continue along.
8/17/2026	Accident Hit and Run	Grand Island Blvd. at Whitehaven Rd.	The complainant reported after being struck from behind, the striking vehicle fled down Whitehaven Rd. Investigation pending.
8/20/2026	Narcotics	Love Rd. at Baseline Rd.	While conducting speed enforcement on Love Rd., patrol observed a motor vehicle speeding and initiated a traffic stop. The operator had a suspended license. Patrol noted the presence of a crumpled up dollar with a white substance – suspected to be crack cocaine - in plain view inside the vehicle. The 60-year-old Grand Island man was charged with 5 th degree Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance, 3 rd degree Aggravated Unlicensed Operation, and multiple Vehicle and Traffic Law infractions.
8/21/2026	Marine – Other	E. River Rd.	Patrol responded to the area of River Oaks Marina after a boat reportedly hit rocks and started taking on water. Five souls aboard. All occupants safely exited the boat.
8/21/2026	Narcotics	E. River Rd.at Fix Rd.	A 43-year-old Grand Island man was found to be in possession of suspected methamphetamine during a traffic stop. He was charged with 7 th degree Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance, Circumvention of Interlock Device, and 2 nd degree Aggravated Unlicensed Operation.
