The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 294 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

8/18	Accident/ First Aid – Drug Related	I-190 @ Staley Rd.	Erie County Sheriff Deputies and State Police responded to an accident that occurred on the Grand Island Bridge. Complainant reported that one of the drivers was unconscious and locked in his vehicle. Patrol arrived to find the subject with blue lips and shallow breathing. Narcan was administered and the subject became responsive a few moments later. Subject was transported to ECMC.
8/19	Domestic Trouble	Whitehaven Rd.	Deputies responded to a complainant that reported that a subject attempted to stab the complainant. Deputies quickly located the subject around the corner and were able to place the subject in custody safely and without incident. The complainant reported that the subject just got released from jail and is not supposed to be at the residence. Complainant wanted charges and a request for an order of protection. The subject was remanded to the ECHC pending arraignment and court review of request for order of protection.
8/21	Larceny	Speedway	Deputies responded to a theft of lottery tickets from the gas station. They provided patrol with video of the customer taking tickets without paying. The subject is known to patrol. Patrol did attempt contact with the subject unsuccessfully and did file for a warrant.
8/22	DWI/ Alcohol	Buffalo Launch Club	Deputies were called to the Buffalo Launch Club for a report of a vehicle striking the building. First aid responded and evaluated the vehicle operator. Deputies observed signs of intoxication. The vehicle operator was transported by ambulance to ECMC. The vehicle operator was arrested for DWI. A criminal history review revealed that the subject has multiple previous DWI convictions and the subject vehicle currently has an interlock device installed. ** Deputies responded to 5 Business Burglary Alarms this week **
