7/25/2026	Motorist Broke Down	I-190	Patrol pulled up behind a vehicle that was stopped on the South Grand Island bridge with its 4-ways on. The operator told patrol that he thought he was on the bridge to Canada and did not want to proceed because he did not have his passport. The subject was advised by patrol that he was still in the United States and given directions.
7/27/2026	Accident Hit and Run	Grand Island Blvd.	A complainant stated that her vehicle was hit and damaged while parked in the Tops parking lot.
7/28/2026	Criminal Mischief	Baseline Rd.	Four parallel scratch marks were left on the liftgate of the complainant's vehicle.
7/30/2026	Larceny	Grand Island Blvd.	Patrol is investigating the theft of approximately \$450 worth of groceries from Tops.
