



## Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 187 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

8/29	Long Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that his vehicle was missing from the parking lot of his place of work. Deputies located the vehicle nearby and determined a co-worker moved the vehicle.
8/29	Whitehaven Rd.	Wires Down	Deputies responded to a report of low hanging wires. Time Warner cable was notified.
8/29	Grand Island Blvd.	Vehicle Fire	Deputies responded to a report of a vehicle fire at the Gulf Station. The Grand Island Fire Department responded and extinguished the small blaze.
8/29	East River Rd.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that sometime overnight an unknown person(s) damaged a political sign that was on her lawn.
8/30	East Park Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that 3 subjects were observed by a car parked in the driveway during the late hours of the night. The subjects continued walking up the street prior to the arrival of Patrol but were located nearby. The subjects were advised.
8/30	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject was sitting in front of Family Dollar and appeared to be drunk. Deputies located the male subject and advised him.
8/30	Buckhorn State Park	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported.
8/30	Grand Island Blvd.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that while she was at Fantasy Island an unknown person(s) broke a window on her vehicle and stole various items from inside.
8/31	West River Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that he heard a tapping on his window during the late hours of the night and observed a male subject walking down the street. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subject by the description given. Nothing was reported damaged or stolen.
8/31	Havenwood La.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	The complainant states that several male subjects were in a white van and walking around some houses under construction during the late evening hours. Deputies located the subjects and advised them.

8/31	Ferry Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Deputies located a vehicle parked near the bike path with all the windows down and no one around during the late evening hours. Deputies went to the registered owners address and spoke with the driver who returned and moved the vehicle.
8/31	Meadow La.	Shots Fired	The complainant states he heard what appeared to be 4 shotgun shots in the area during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked the area but did not hear any more shots.
9/1	Ferry Rd.	Marijuana Possession	Deputies located a suspicious vehicle parked at Anchor Marine occupied by several subjects during the late hours of the night. Deputies investigation led to the arrest of 3 Juvenile Offenders for Unlawful Possession of Marijuana (Violation). The Juvenile Offenders were issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
9/1	Stony Point Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a bunch of kids were banging on the door and yelling obscenities before getting into a vehicle and leaving the area. Deputies checked for the vehicle but were unable to locate it by the description given.
9/1	West River Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that an unknown person(s) rang his doorbell and ran off during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any subjects.
9/1	Town Hall Terr.	Customer Trouble	A Taxi driver states that a subject left without paying for the cab fare. Deputies located the subject who returned and paid the fee.
9/1	Love Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle became disabled.
9/1	Fix Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that several male subjects pulled up in front of a residence and stole a weed wacker lying in the driveway. The subjects then fled in an unknown direction of travel. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle or subjects involved.
9/1	Whitehaven Rd.	Property Found	The complainant found a bicycle on her property and wanted to turn it over to Patrol. Deputies secured the bike and took it the substation to await contact from an owner.
9/2	Ransom Rd.	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that a silver colored vehicle was speeding down the road. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
9/2	Carter Dr.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that 2 male subjects were yelling at each other in an apparent road rage incident. Both drivers left the scene prior to the arrival of Patrol. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicles by the description given.
9/3	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident Injury	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a bicyclist. The bicyclist was treated on scene with seemingly non-life threatening injuries.
9/3	East River Rd.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that sometime in recent days an unknown person(s) burned a hammock on her property.

9/3	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident in the parking lot of M&T Bank. No injuries were reported.
9/3	Long Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime in recent days an unknown person(s) stole various items from a construction site.
9/3	West River Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	The complainant states that a male subject driving a maroon Chevrolet pickup truck drove slowly through the area several times. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
9/3	Fix Rd.	Noise Complaint	The complainant states that loud music was coming from a party somewhere nearby in the neighborhood during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked the area and determined the complaint unfounded.
9/3	Staley Rd.	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported.
9/3	South State Pkwy.	Suspicious Person	Deputies located 3 subjects on bicycles during the late hours of the night. 2 of the subjects fled the area when they noticed Patrol. Deputies advised the 3 <sup>rd</sup> subject who left without incident.
9/4	Love Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states she observed a black pickup truck in front of her residence during the late hours of the night and then heard a loud bang. Deputies located 2 subjects and the vehicle and determined they were loading a bicycle in the back and dropped it.
9/4	Carl Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject walked into the woods and a short time later she heard 2 shots fired. Deputies located the subject who stated he recently bought the gun and wanted to see if it worked. The subject was advised.
9/4	Love Rd.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 21 y/o Zachary Steinbrenner of Grand Island for Operating a Vehicle with a Suspended Registration (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed is registration was suspended. Steinbrenner was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
9/4	East River Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	Deputies located an occupied vehicle parked at Fisherman's Landing during the late hours of the night. The occupants were advised and left without incident.
