



## Erie County Sheriff's Office Weekly Blotter

**Dates: August 29 – September 4, 2026**

**The Erie County Sheriff's Office handled 2,350 complaints during the reporting period. This includes:**

- **421 premises checks**
- **52 neighborhood patrols**
- **226 traffic stops**
- **236 calls to assist other agencies**
- **21 warrants served**

**On the evening of September 2, patrols responded to multiple road obstruction calls across the county due to severe weather.**
