The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 214 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
9/5	East River Rd.	Noise Complaint	The complainant states that loud music was being played from a nearby residence that was causing his walls to shake. Deputies checked the area and determined the complaint was unfounded.
9/5	Bedell Rd.	Animal Loose	The complainant states that a small dog was wandering around in the area. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
9/5	Beaver Island State Park	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that a male subject who appeared to be intoxicated got into a black dodge Durango and drove out of the park. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
9/5	I-190	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle became disabled when a tire went flat.
9/5	Grand Island Blvd.	Customer Trouble	Employees of KOA campground state that several subjects at a campsite were playing music too loud and disturbing other guests. Deputies spoke with and advised all parties.
9/5	Bedell Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that his ex-girlfriend reported to him that some money and a bank card were missing from her apartment. Deputies went and spoke to the female who stated she misplaced the money.
9/6	Red Jacket Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that she heard someone in her yard during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any persons.
9/6	Lakeview Terr.	Noise Complaint	The complainant states that loud banging was coming from a neighboring apartment during the late hours of the night. Deputies spoke with the occupants and advised them.
9/6	Love Rd.	Traffic Complaint	The employee of 7-11 states that a vehicle drove into the parking lot and struck a pole before leaving the area. The employee was able to get a license plate number and patrol located the vehicle parked at the registered owners address. The driver was advised, no damage was reported.

9/6	Grand Island Blvd.	Disorderly Person	Employees of Burger King state that a male subject was causing a disturbance. The male subject got into a vehicle and left the area but an employee was able to obtain a license plate number. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle. Employees did not wish to pursue anything further.
9/6	Riverview Ct.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
9/6	East River Rd.	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that a driver of another vehicle threw a beer can at his car while driving on the I-190. The complainant followed the vehicle until Deputies arrived. All parties were advised.
9/7	East Park Rd.	Trespass	The complaint states that sometime in recent days an unknown person(s) broke a lock on her garage door and entered the area. Nothing was reported stolen.
9/7	East River Rd.	Accident Injury	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a tree. The driver was taken to a local hospital with seemingly non-life threatening injuries.
9/7	East River Rd.	Noise Complaint	The complainant states that loud music was coming from a nearby residence. Deputies located the source of the music and advised the occupants.
9/7	South State Pkwy.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle became disable near the intersection of Love Rd.
9/7	Bedell Rd.	Shots Fired	The complainant states he heard 3 gun shots in the area of the Country Glen Apartments. Deputies spoke with several people in the area and determined the noise came from an unknown person(s) using fireworks.
9/8	East Park Rd.	Open Door	The complainant states that doors and windows to a neighboring vacant house were open. Deputies checked the residence but found no person(s) inside. The door was re-secured by Patrol.
9/8	Grand Island Blvd.	Larceny	The complainant states that while she was at Fantasy Island an unknown person(s) stole various items including credit cards from her vehicle. The credit cards were also used at various locations nearby after the theft occurred. Investigation Ongoing.
9/8	Bedell Rd.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that sometime during the weekend an unknown person(s) vandalized the bathroom trailer in Veterans Park causing a large amount of damage.
9/8	Grand Island Blvd.	Larceny	The complainant states that while she was at Bailly's Food Market a known subject stole \$20 from her. Deputies located the subject nearby who agreed to return the money. The complainant did not wish to pursue charges and was satisfied the money was returned.
9/8	Bedell Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	Deputies located an occupied vehicle parked in Veterans Park during the late hours of the night. The occupants were advised and left without incident.
9/8	Enola Rd.	Accident Hit & Run	The complainant states that a vehicle struck his car and then fled the scene. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
9/8	Baseline Rd.	Accident Injury	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. The driver was transported to a local hospital

			with seemingly non-life threatening injuries.
9/8	Schutt Ct.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a suspicious van was parked in the street for approximately 20 minutes and none of the occupants exited. The vehicle left prior to the arrival of Patrol. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
9/8	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	Deputies located a suspicious person at Bailly's Food Market after closing hours. The subject was advised and left without incident.
9/9	I-190	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that a black pickup truck was driving with no headlights on during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked the area but located no vehicle traveling without headlights on.
9/10	I-190	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle became disabled near the South Grand Island Bridge.
9/10	Broadway	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a male subject was walking around her property. Deputies checked the area but found no persons walking through the yards. No damage was observed and nothing was reported stolen.
9/10	Bedell Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that the odor of marijuana was emanating from a nearby apartment in her complex. Deputies spoke with numerous subjects but were unable to locate the source of the smell.
9/10	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident Injury	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. 1 driver was transported to a local hospital with seemingly non-life threatening injuries.
9/11	Riverdale Dr.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
9/11	Whitehaven Rd.	Traffic Complaint	The complainant states that a white vehicle with out of state plates was driving recklessly. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
