9/5/2026	Marine – Other	Niagara River	Marine Unit deputies ticketed the operator of a vessel for failing to produce a valid safety certificate.
9/5/2026	Fraud	Stony Point Rd.	After responding to a report of a vehicle in a ditch, patrol spoke with the operator, a 26-year-old West Seneca woman. The woman, who had an active warrant out of Lackawanna, originally gave patrol a false name. She was charged with False Personation and transported to the Erie County Holding Center.
9/6/2026	Fireworks – Use	Center Ct. North	A complainant called dispatch to report multiple gunshots being fired in the area. Patrol responded and determined the sound was caused by fireworks.
9/7/2026	Accident – PDO	Harvey Rd.	A motor vehicle struck and destroyed two mailboxes on the listed road. The operator was issued a ticket for failure to maintain his lane.
