The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 152 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **<u>Grand Island</u>**.

9/15	Grand Island Blvd.	Reckless Operation	Complainant states that a vehicle was speeding on Grand Island Blvd. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle.
9/15	Broadway	Suspicious Incident	Complainant states that an unknown person(s) intentionally drove over his lawn sometime during the night.
9/15	East River Rd.	Reckless Operation	Complainant states that a vehicle was speeding on East River Rd. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle.
9/15	Love Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Complainant stated that a vehicle was on fire. Deputies assisted Grand Island Fire Department. The vehicle had apparently overheated but was not on fire.

9/16	East River Rd.	Loud Music	Complainant states that loud music was coming from a residence in the neighborhood late at night. Deputies located the residence and advised the owner.
9/16	Jenell Dr.	Suspicious Person	Complainant states that a male subject appeared intoxicated and was walking in the roadway. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subject.
9/16	River Oaks Dr.	Criminal Mischief	Complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) keyed his car and caused damage.
9/16	Whitehaven Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Complainant states that a vehicle was parked on Whitehaven Rd. near the power lines and was concerned because tree stands had been stolen/damaged in the past. Deputies located the vehicle but no subjects were in the area.
9/16	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Vehicle	Complainant states that a suspicious vehicle was parked in the Tim Hortons parking lot and was possibly occupied. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle.
9/16	Long Rd.	ATV Operation	Complainant states that ATV's appeared to be riding on private property in the area. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the ATV's

9/16	Evelyn Ct.	Found Property	Complainant states a bicycle was lying in the street and did not belong to any neighbors. Deputies brought the bicycle to the substation to be claimed.
9/17	Baseline Rd.	Animal Loose	Complainant states a large dog was running loose in the neighborhood. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
9/17	Baseline Rd.	Larceny	Complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) stole various construction equipment from a work site. Investigation Ongoing.
9/17	East River Rd.	Larceny	Complainant states sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) stole various items from his boat.
9/17	Ransom Rd.	Road Obstruction	Deputies located objects in the roadway on Ransom Rd. that were removed.
9/17	Orchard Rd.	Reckless Operation	Complainant states that a motorcycle was revving its engine and driving up and down the street. Deputies checked but were unable to locate the motorcycle.
9/18	Marilyn Dr.	Suspicious Incident	Complainant states she thought she heard noises coming from outside of her bedroom window. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any subjects. The windows and doors did not appear to be tampered with.
9/18	Warner Dr.	Animal Complaint	Complainant stated that a dog appeared to be in distress at a residence in the area. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
9/18	Whitehaven Rd.	Traffic Control Device	Deputies notified NITTEC of a signal that was flashing red on all sides at the intersection of Whitehaven Rd. and Baseline Rd.
9/18	Whitehaven Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.
9/18	Grand Island Blvd.	Narcotics Arrest	Following a complaint of a suspicious vehicle, Deputies arrested 26 y/o Adam Hamilton of Tonawanda for Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 7 <sup>th</sup> Degree and multiple vehicle and traffic infractions. Hamilton was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
9/18	West River Rd.	Suspicious Incident	Complainant states that someone was shining a flashlight into the rear window of her residence. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any subjects.
9/19	Whitehaven Rd.	Welfare Check	Deputies received a 911 hang up call from the Grand Island Small Animal Hospital. Deputies spoke to employees and determined the call to be a mistake.
9/19	South State Pkwy.	Drunk Driving	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 54 y/o Michele Clifford of West Seneca for Driving While Intoxicated. Clifford refused to submit a sample of her breathe for chemical analysis. Clifford was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court and was released to a sober 3 <sup>rd</sup> party.
9/20	Bedell Rd.	Water Break	Deputies located a water main break on Bedell Rd. Grand Island Water Authority was notified.
9/20	Buckhorn State Park	Animal Loose	Complainant states a dog was running loose in the area. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
9/21	South State Pkwy.	Reckless Operation	Complainant states that a vehicle was travelling northbound in the southbound lanes on South State Pkwy. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle.

9/21	Broadway	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up. Deputies spoke to the occupants who stated a family member was choking but was ok now.
9/21	Whitehaven Rd.	Traffic Control Device	Deputies notified NITTEC of a signal that was flashing red on all sides at the intersection of Whitehaven Rd. and Baseline Rd.
